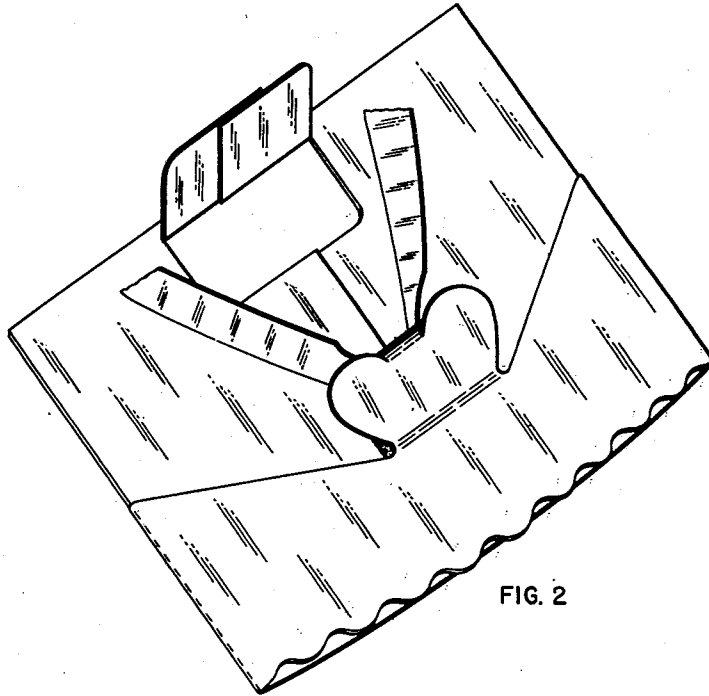

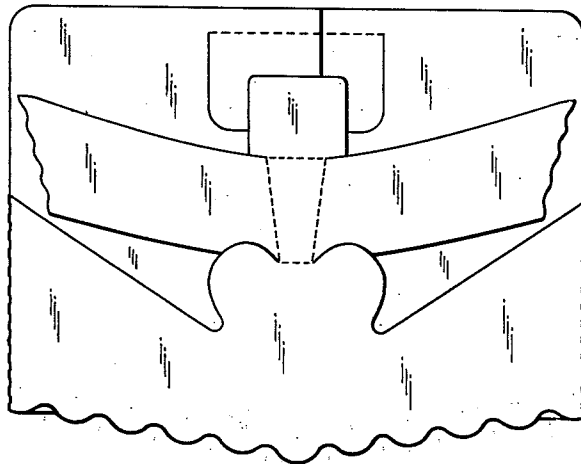

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Harry A. Tomarin, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Shirt and Collar Protector, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
