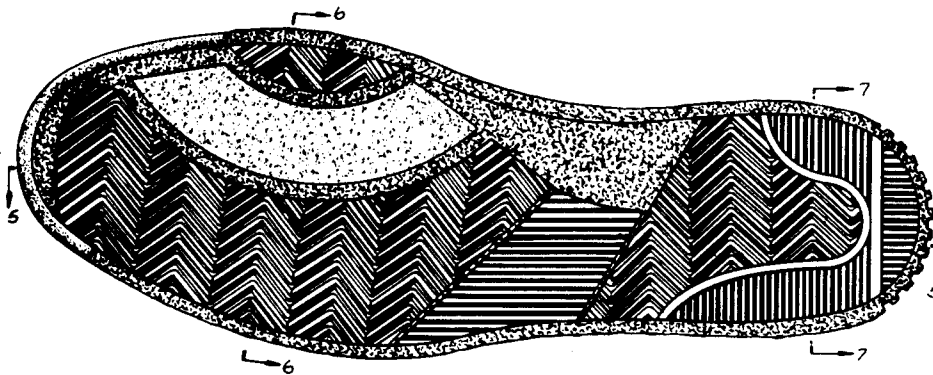
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sole for a shoe, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a sole for a shoe showing our new design, the top being plain and unornamented;  
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 5—5 of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 6—6 of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 7—7 of FIG. 1.

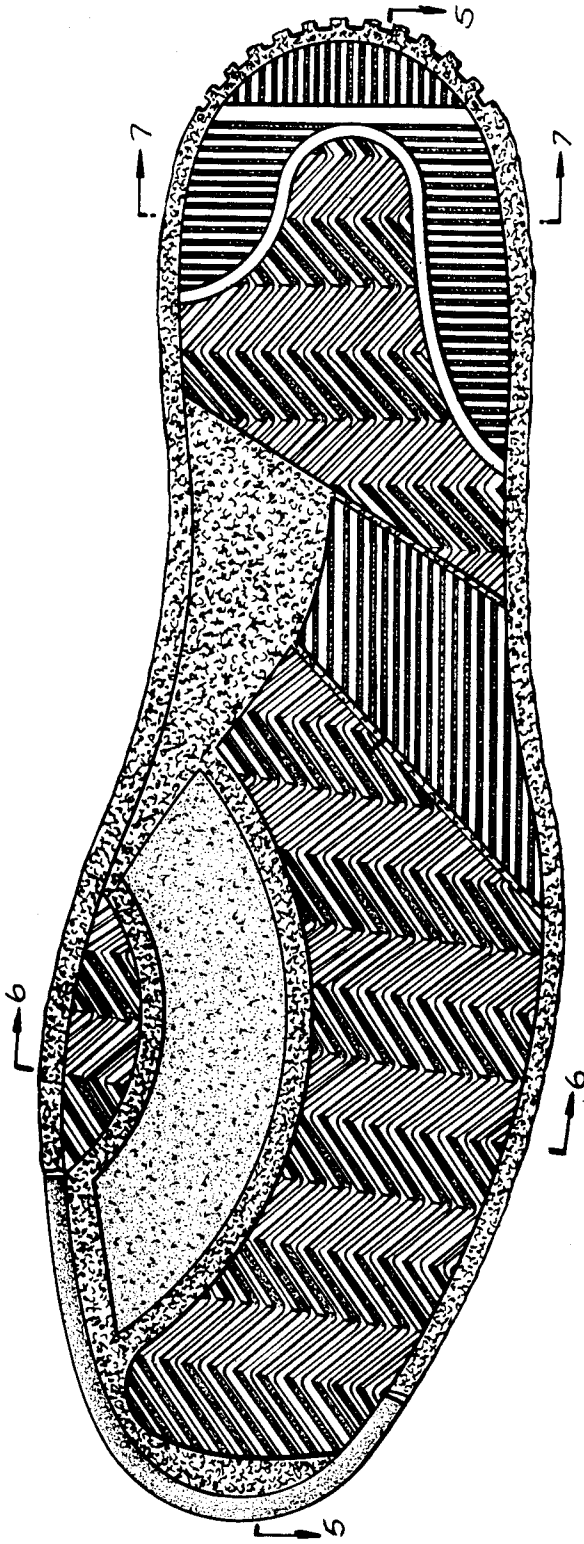

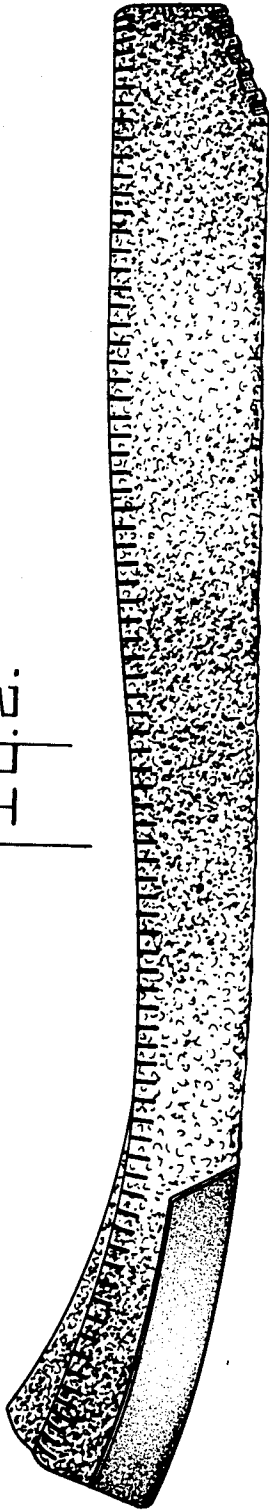

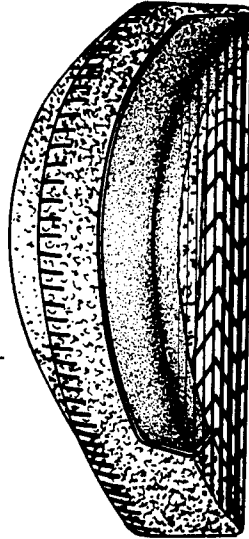

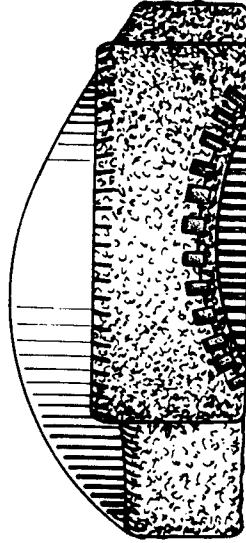

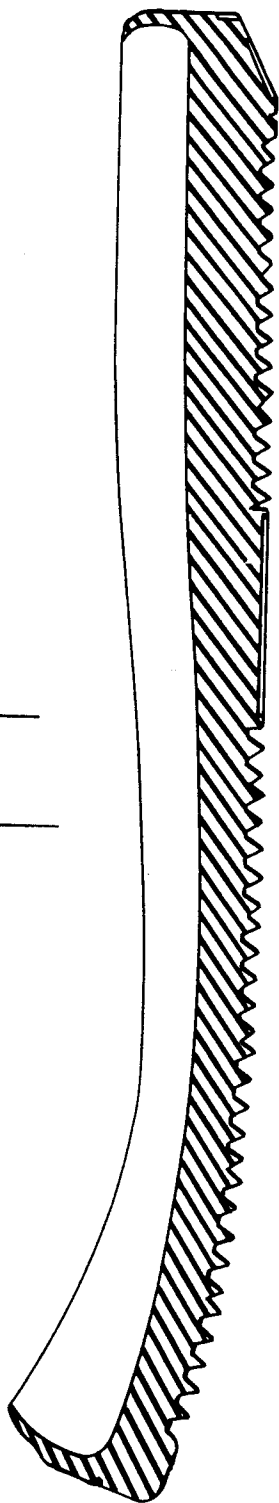

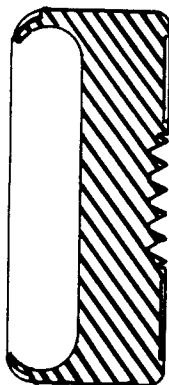
