

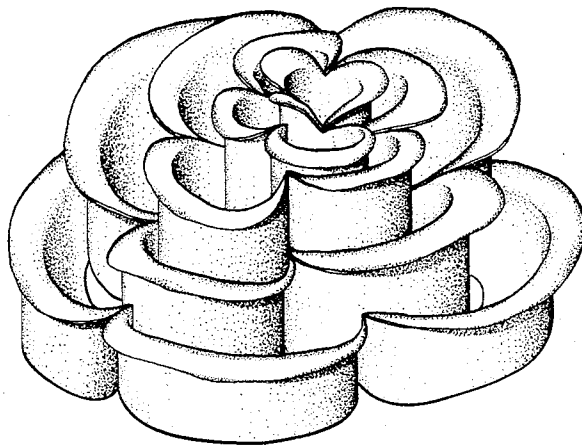

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert F. Duryea, a citizen of the United States, residing at Palo Alto, in the county of Santa Clara and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Flower Holder or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The flower holder is substantially round and symmetrical throughout
