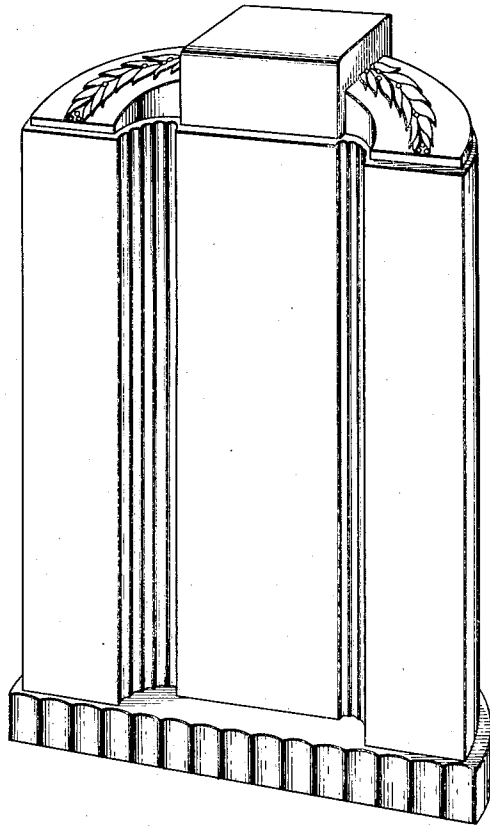

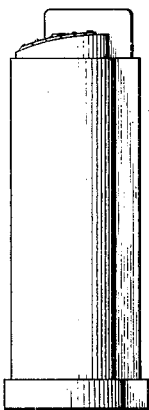

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William B. Petzold, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsfield, in the county of Berkshire, State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Trophy Base, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the accompanying drawing, Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the trophy base showing my new design and Fig. 2 is a view in side elevation thereof.
