wrap shown in FIG. 1.

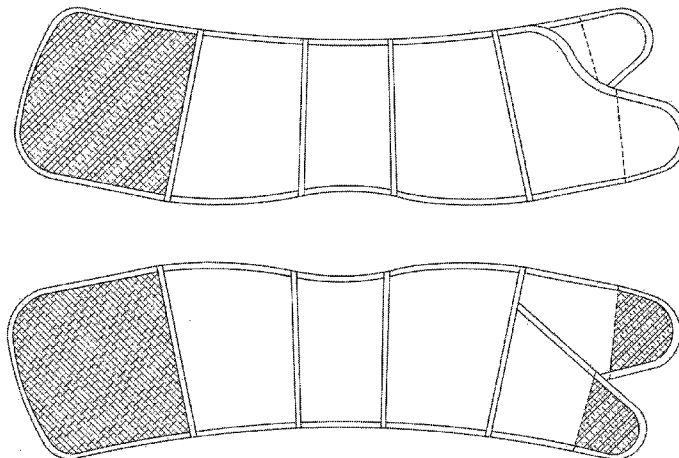
FIG. 6 is a first end elevational view of the abdominal wrap

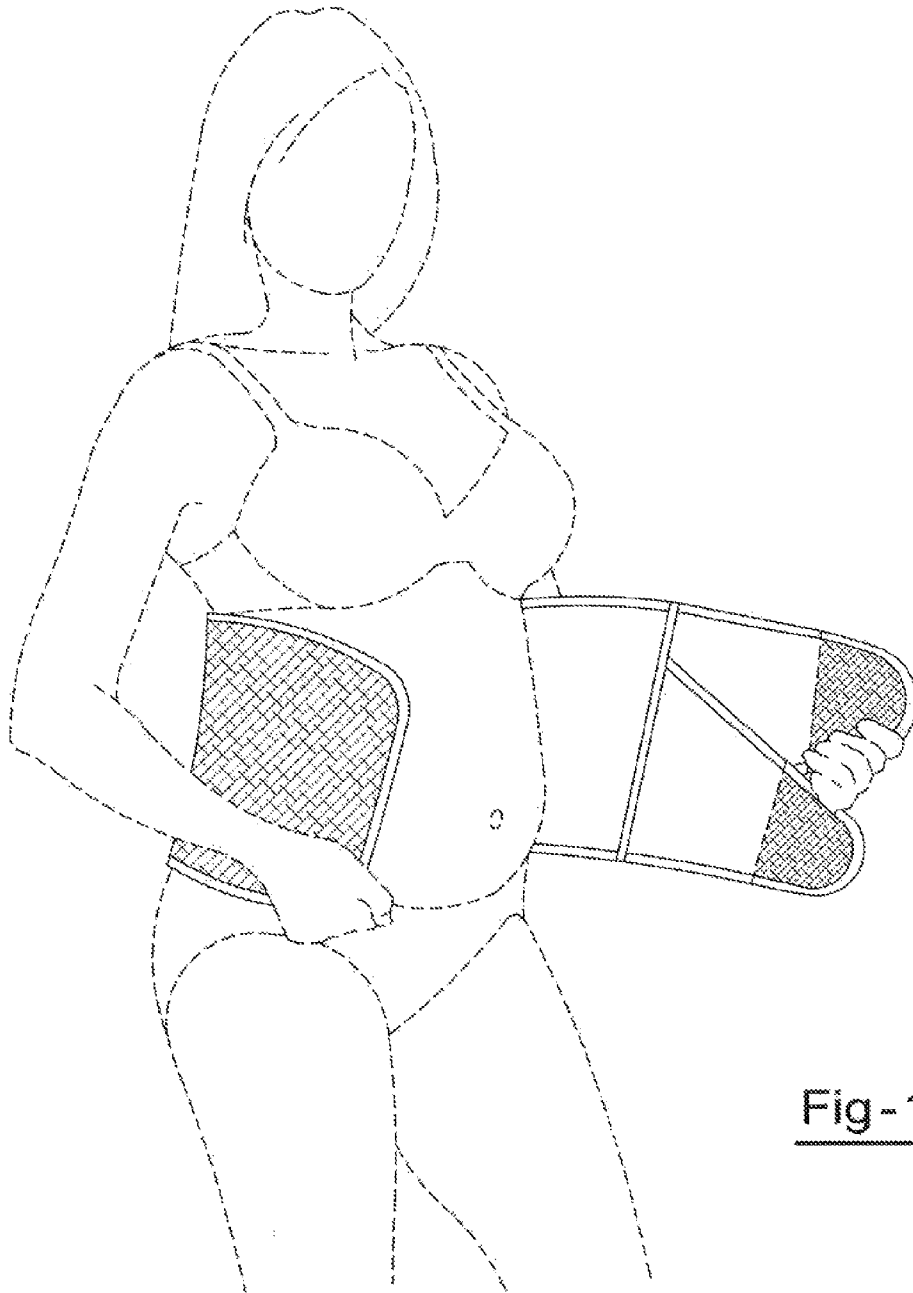

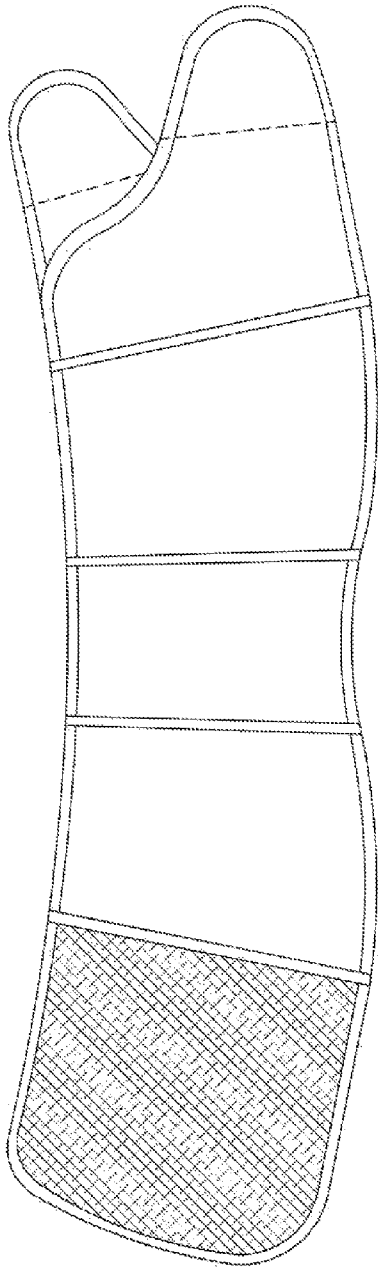

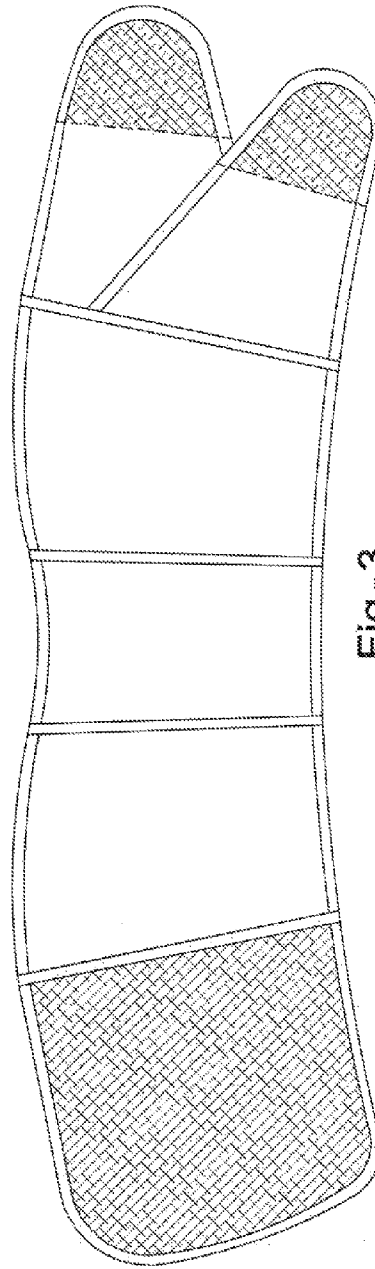

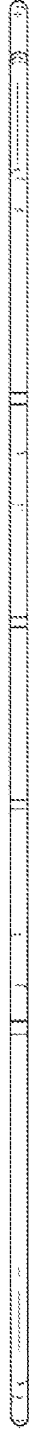

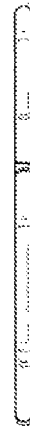
