

DESIGN FOR A RADIATOR SHELL

Application filed December 21, 1929. Serial No. 33,885. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERBERT V. HENDERSON, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Detroit, county of Wayne, and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Radiator Shell, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, in which—
