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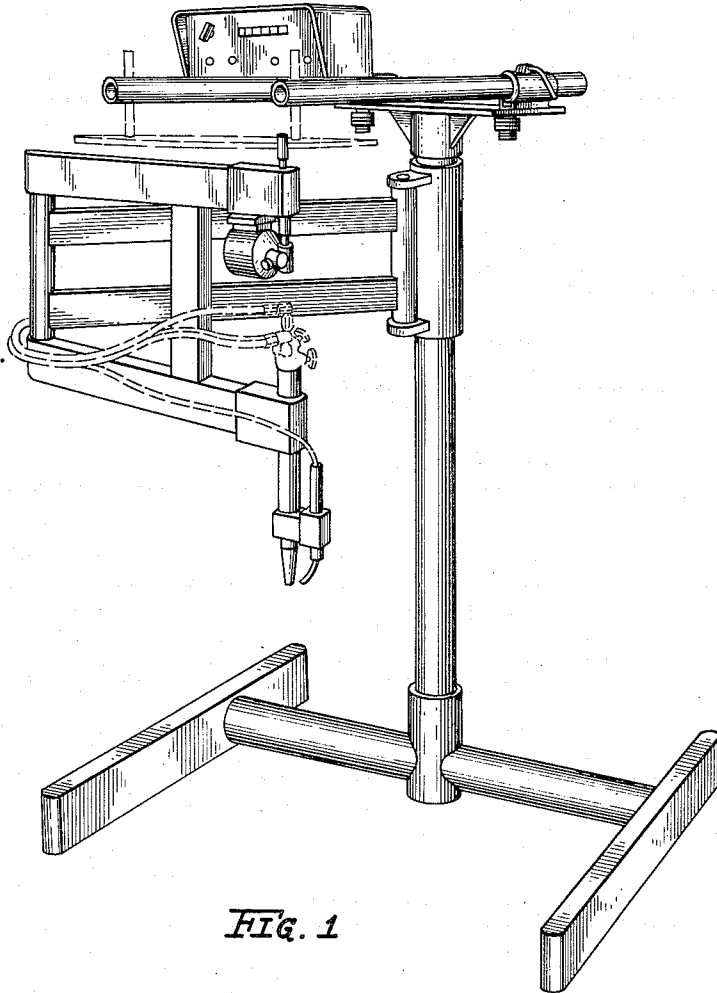

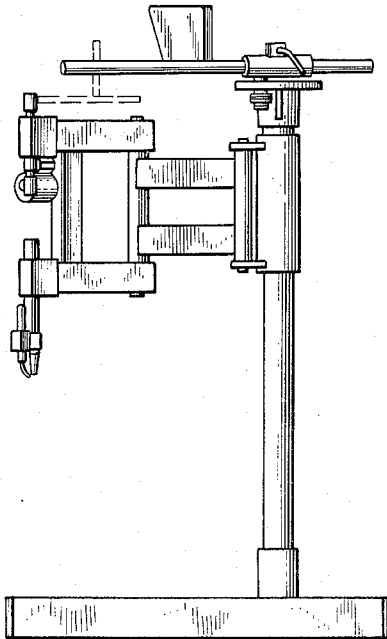
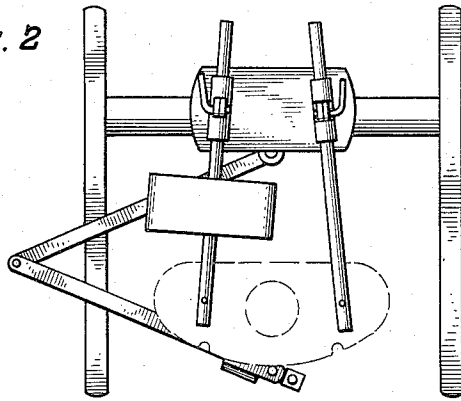
Fig. 2*Fig. 3*

FIGURE 1 is a perspective view of a pattern-controlled cutting machine incorporating the design of the present invention;

FIGURE 2 is a plan view of the pattern-controlled cutting machine of FIGURE 1; and

FIGURE 3 is a side-elevational view of the same machine.

With reference to the drawing, the dominant features of the design reside in the portions shown in full lines, broken lines being utilized to show that which is immaterial.

Parts of the broken line portions in FIGURES 2 and 3 have been omitted for convenience of illustration only.
