Design for a Carpet Pattern.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that E. Elemer J. Key of Lowell, in the County of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Carpets or other fabrics, of which the following is a full, clear and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making part of this specification.

This design consists of combinations of gourds, palm leaves, blocks, leaves and other figures of a Persian style, the whole being so arranged as to constitute the particular pattern shown in the drawings.

The colors employed for the different portions of the design, may be varied to suit the taste and wish of the manufacturer.
