

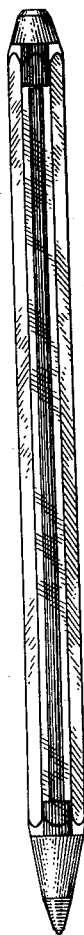

### *To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Valtin H. Lust, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 184 Main Street, Ridgefield Park, in the State of New Jersey, United States of America, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Ball Point Pencil, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein the figure is an elevational view of a ball point pencil, showing my new design.

The design is characterized by symmetrical conical dark ends and a central longitudinal dark line linking said ends and visible through the transparent body.

### I claim:

The ornamental design for a ball point pencil, as shown and described.
