[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chest or the like, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chest or the like showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a second embodiment of the ornament shown on the rear of the chest in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 8 is a third embodiment of the ornament shown on the rear of the chest in FIG. 1; and  
 FIG. 9 is a fourth embodiment of the ornament shown on the rear of the chest in FIG. 1.
