(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for an infant wearable device, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an elevation view of the left side of the infant wearable device;

FIG. 2 is an elevation view of the front of the infant wearable device;

FIG. 3 is an elevation view of the right side of the infant wearable device;

FIG. 4 is a plan view of the bottom of the infant wearable device;

FIG. 5 is an elevation view of the back of the infant wearable device;

FIG. 6 is an elevation view of the front of the infant wearable device installed in a band;

FIG. 7 is a plan view of the top of the infant wearable device installed in a band;



FIG. 8 is an elevation view of the right side of the infant wearable device installed in a band;

FIG. 9 is an isometric view, from the front left, of the infant wearable device installed in a band; and,

















