The ornamental design for a pitcher, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 shows a perspective view of a pitcher showing my new design, according to an embodiment of the invention. FIG. 2 shows a front, elevation view of the pitcher shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 11 shows a right, elevation view of the pitcher shown in FIG. 8.


FIG. 12 shows a left, elevation view of the pitcher shown in FIG. 8.


























