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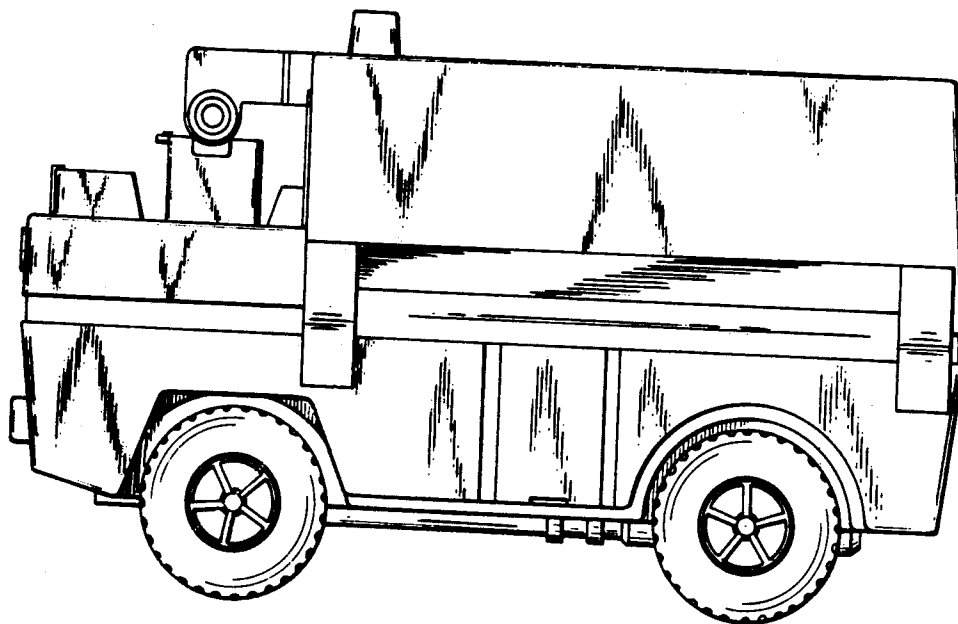

CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy rescue truck, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a toy rescue truck showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



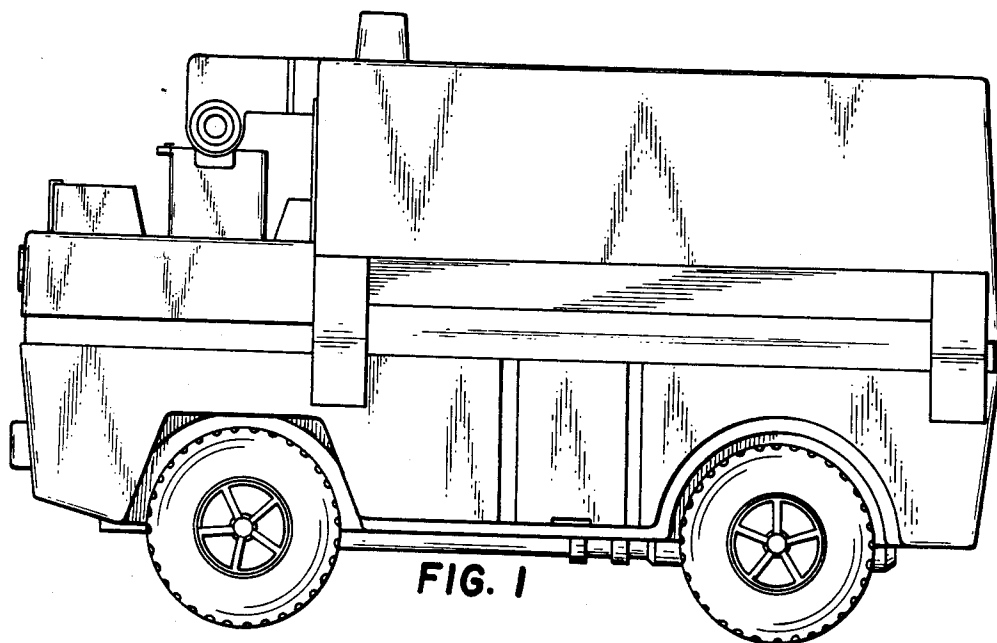

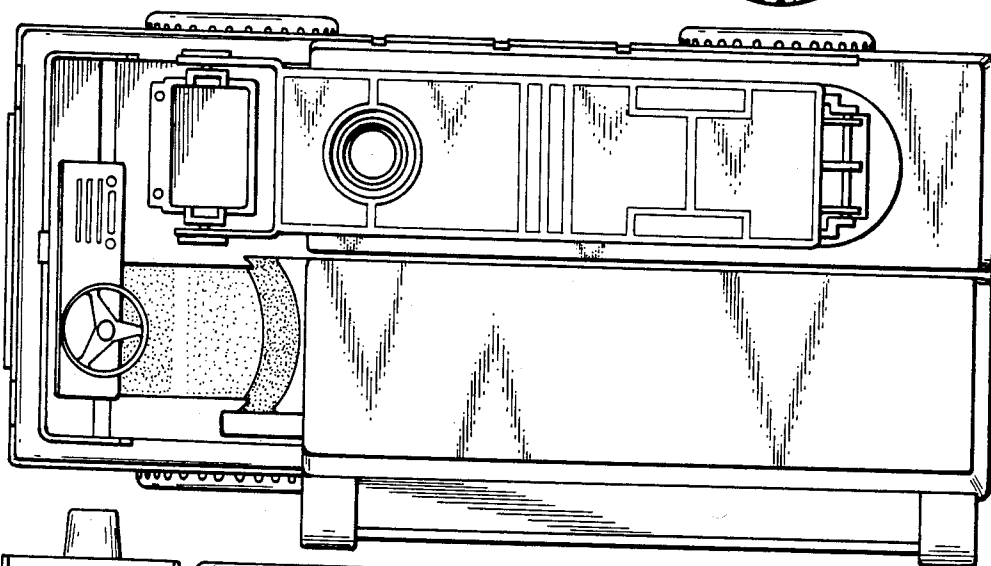

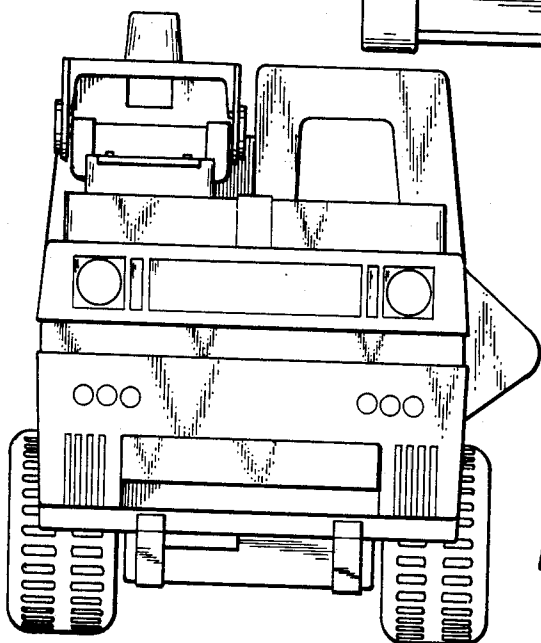
