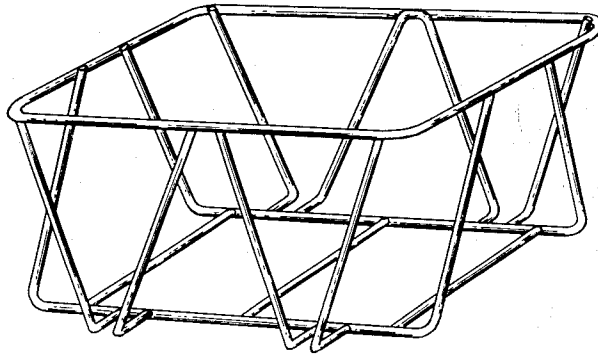

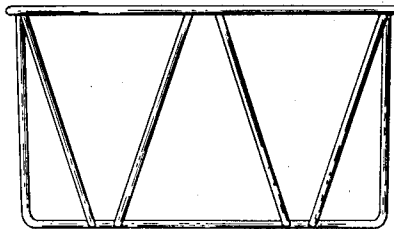
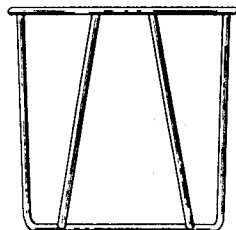

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ernst F. Engstrom, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shipping Container or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a shipping container showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the shipping container.

Figure 3 is an end elevational view of the shipping container.
