FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

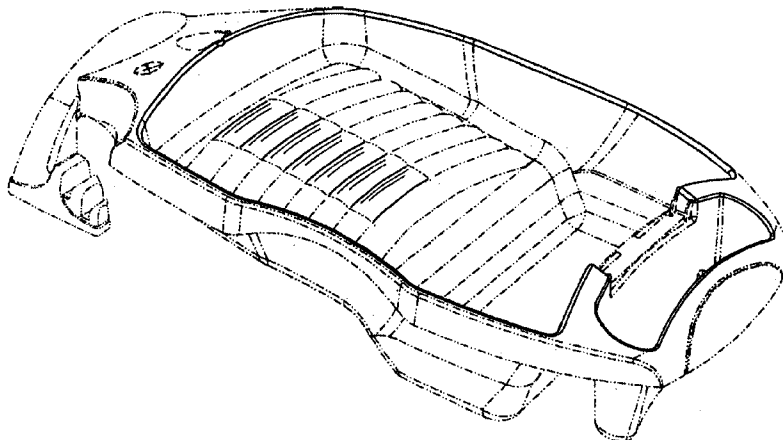
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view thereof being identical to the right elevational view shown; and,

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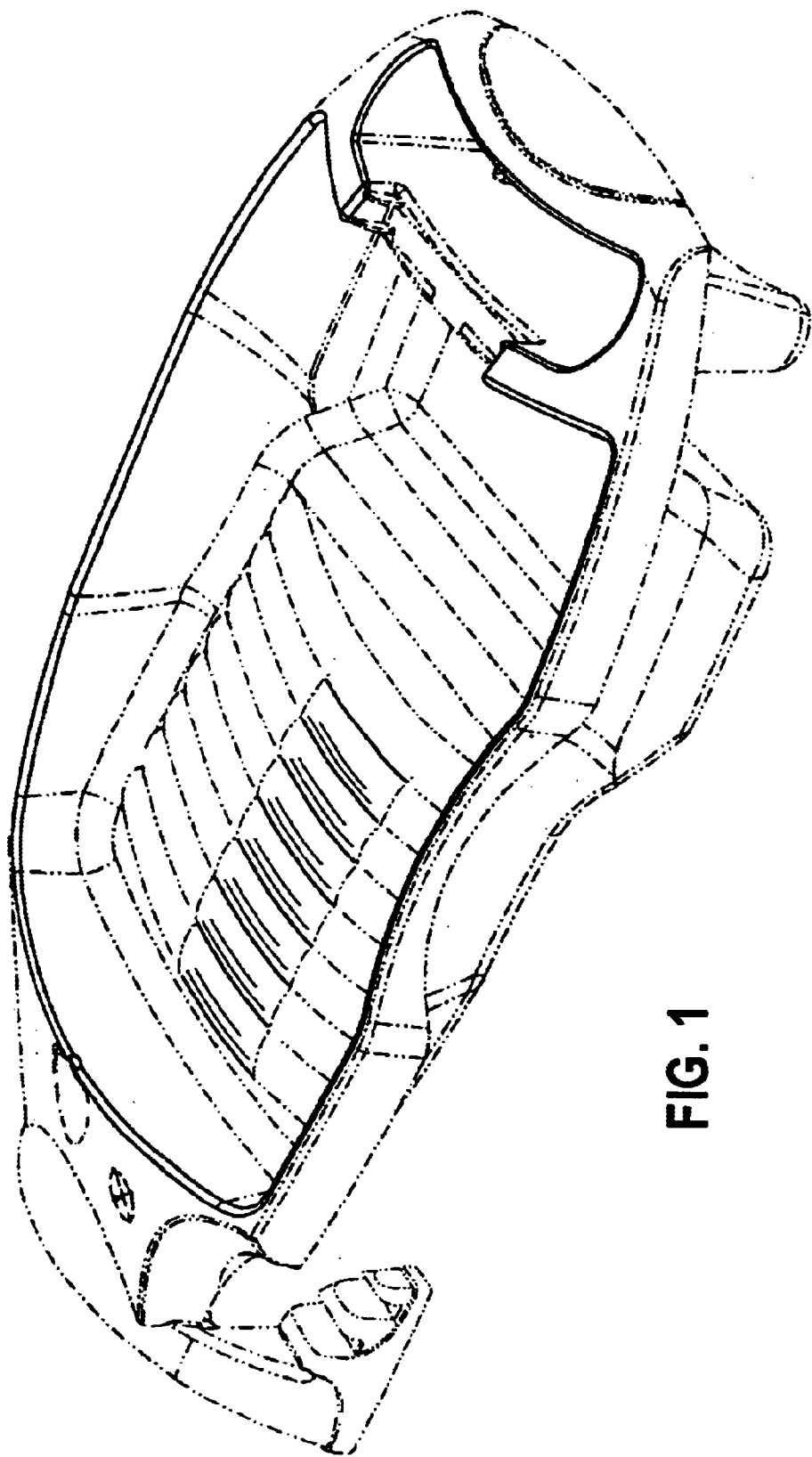

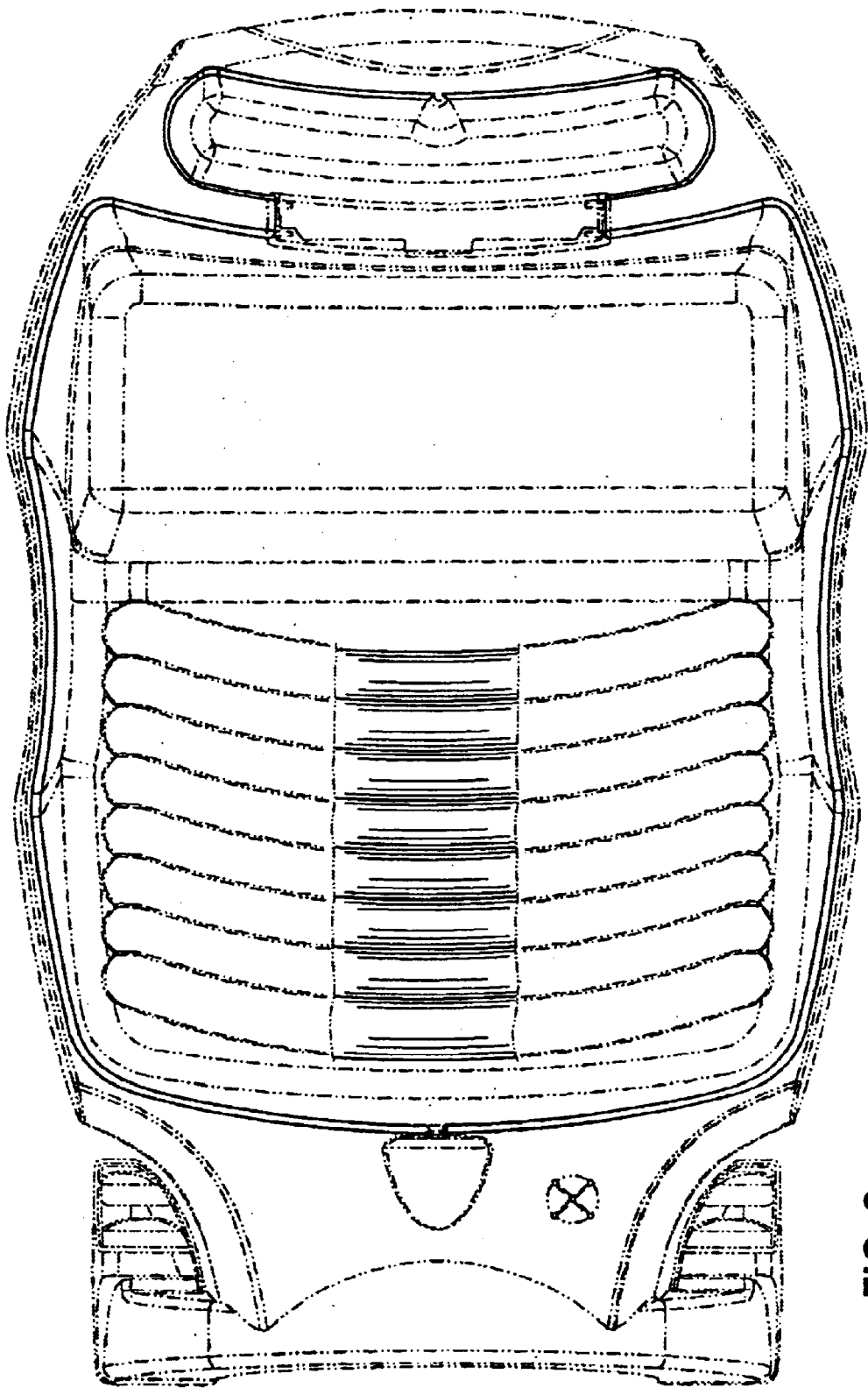

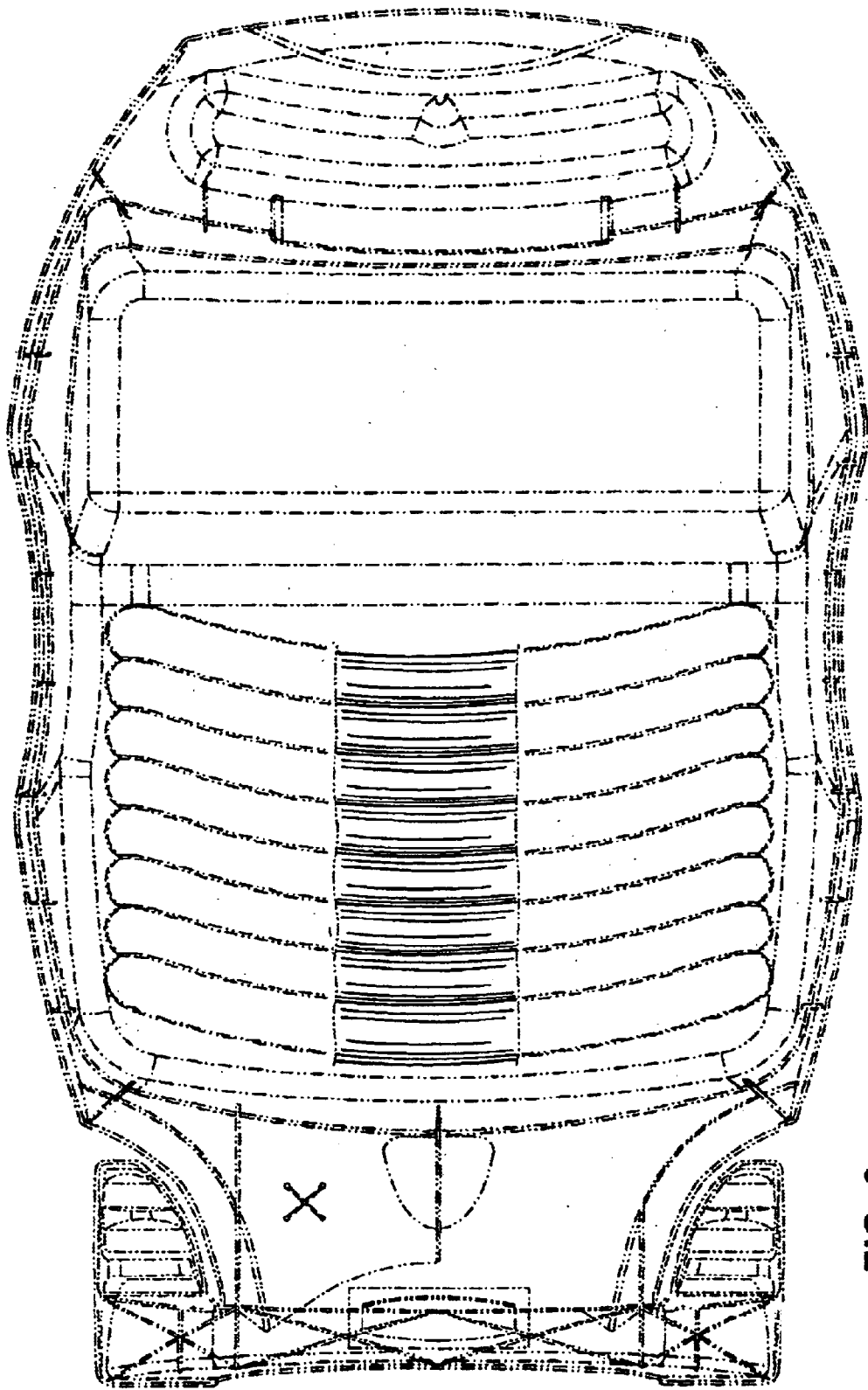

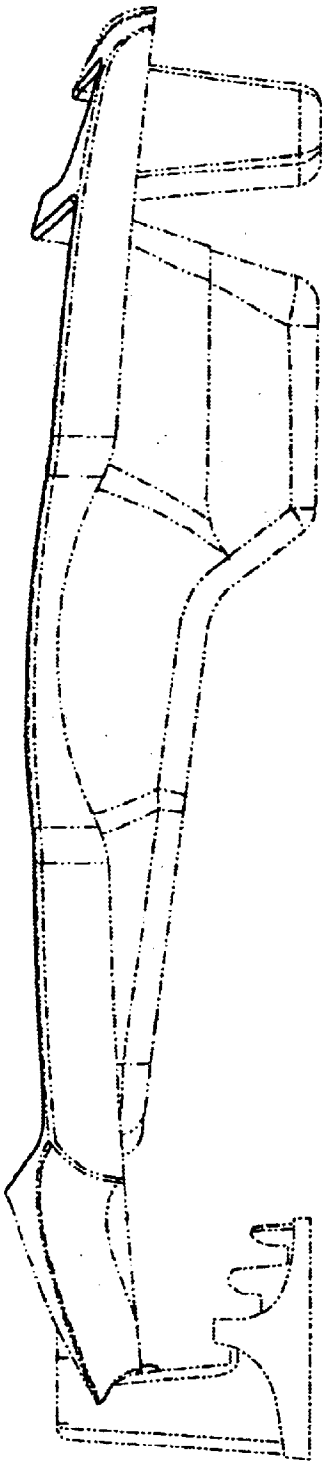

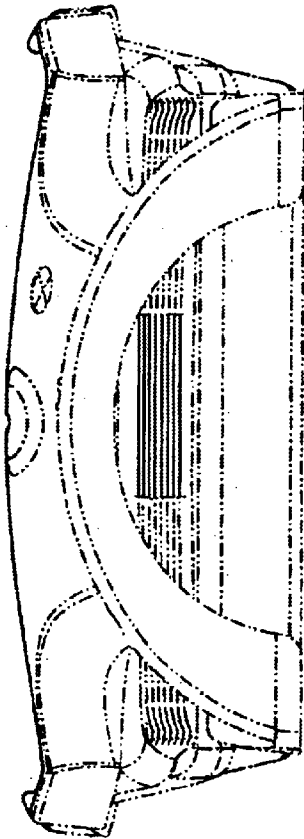

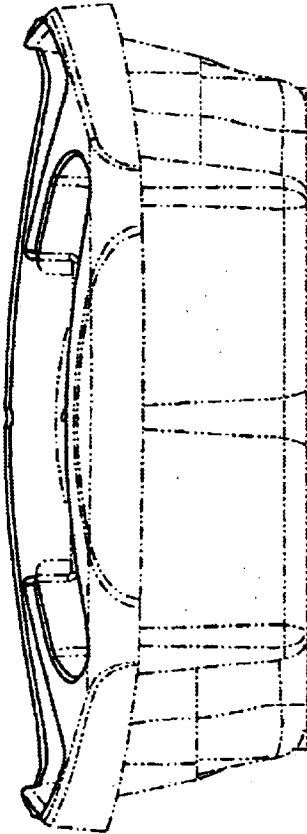
