


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Philip C. Waite, a citizen of the United States, residing at Oshkosh, in the county of Winnebago and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Floor Covering, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a floor covering embodying my new design, the view exhibiting a corner section thereof which is partly turned forwardly to show a portion of its rear face, the block pattern which characterizes the illustrated corner section being repeated regularly on both of its faces throughout the entire area thereof; and

Fig. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary view of a portion of the floor covering illustrating the texture in detail.
