

PORTABLE MUSKET-RACK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 321,930, dated July 7, 1885.

Application filed July 7, 1884. (No model.)

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GENNARO WUNDER-LICK, of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new and valuable Improvement in Portable Musket-Racks; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description of the construction and operation of the same, reference being had to the 10 annexed drawings, making a part of this specification, and to the letters and figures of reference marked thereon.

Figure 1 of the drawings is a side elevation of my invention. Figs. 2 and 3 are plans of

15 the parts composing the same.

My invention has for its object to provide a portable gun or musket rack and a combined gun and clothes rack.

My invention accordingly consists of the 20 combination, construction, and arrangement

of parts as hereinafter described and claimed. In the drawings, A represents the rack, composed of two brackets or members, B C, the former being the upper one or that for receiv-25 ing the nozzle or bayonet end of the gun, and the latter the lower one or that in which the stock of the gun is placed and supported. Each bracket is composed of two plates d and d', the lower plate, d', having a back, d^2 , for 30 the top plate, d, to rest upon, and both plates have a series of aligning openings, d3, in which are swiveled the supporting arms for the gun and the hooks for the hats or clothes, as shown. These plates, arms, and hooks are held in po- $_{35}$ sition relatively to one another by screws band nuts b', which pass through the plates, as illustrated. The back-plates, d^2 , are provided with screws ff, one of which carries a plate, F, having, if desired, notches or openings for 40 engagement with the said screws and adjustable nuts f^2 , as shown, whereby said brackets may be applied to a post or other support, and detached therefrom as occasion demands. Such construction affords a portable gun and 45 clothes rack. The bracket C is provided with the arm G, having pivoted curved seat g, with

side and end projections g', in which the stock

of the gun is placed. The arm T of bracket B has a pivoted or hinged piece or claw, H, for grasping the nozzle of the gun, and is held 50 in contact therewith by a spring, K, the end of which works in a groove, b^2 , in the top of claw H. As the gun is inserted in or with-drawn from its rack, the seat g and claw H move on their pivotal or hinged connections 55 to yield to the pressure applied to the gun in effecting its insertion and withdrawal to and from its rack.

What I claim is—

1. The combination, with bracket C, having 60 swiveled arm G and pivoted seat g, of bracket B, having swiveled arm H, as and for the pur-

pose set forth.

2. The combination of brackets B and C, having fastening screws f and swiveled hooks 65 L, the arm G, having pivoted seat g and swiveled in bracket C, and arm H, swiveled in bracket B, substantially as shown and described.

3. The bracket B, composed of plate d', hav- 70 ing back d^2 , with holes or openings d^3 , plate d', with aligning apertures d^3 , connecting serew or rod b', fastening-screws f and nuts f^2 , and swiveled arm I, having hinged claw H, with reacting spring K, substantially as shown and 75 described.

4. The bracket B, comprising plates d d', with back d^2 , aligning apertures d^3 , fastening screw or rod b, swiveled arm I, having hinged claw H, with spring K, the screws ff, having 80 adjustable nuts f^2 , and plate F, substantially as and for the purpose set forth.

5. The bracket C, having fastening screws and nuts ff^2 , and swiveled arm G, having pivoted seat g, substantially as and for the pur- 85
