

VEHICLE WINDSHIELD SHADE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Richard E. Dieterich, a citizen of the United States and resident of River Forest, Illinois, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vehicle Windshield Shade, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof;

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a vehicle windshield shade, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a fragmentary top plan view of the same.

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view of the same. I claim:

The ornamental design for a vehicle windshield shade, substantially as shown.
