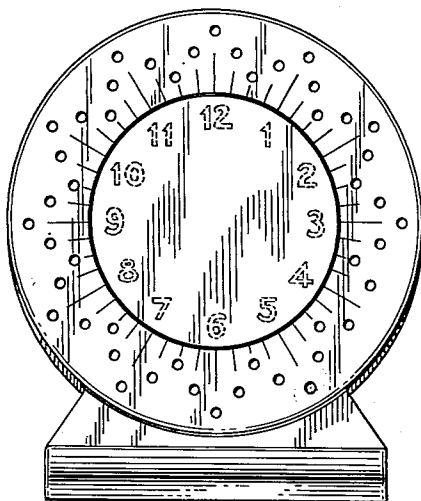

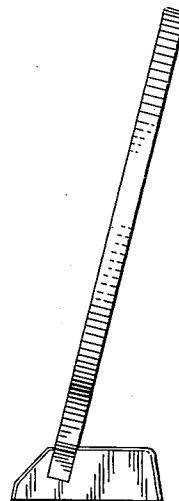

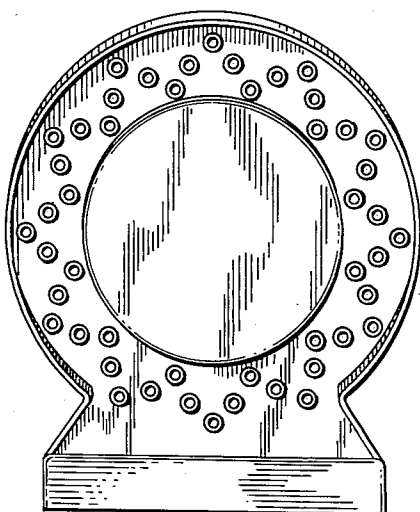
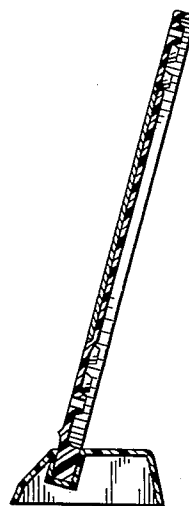

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George D. Thornton, a citizen of the United States, residing at Berkley, State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Television Reminder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.
