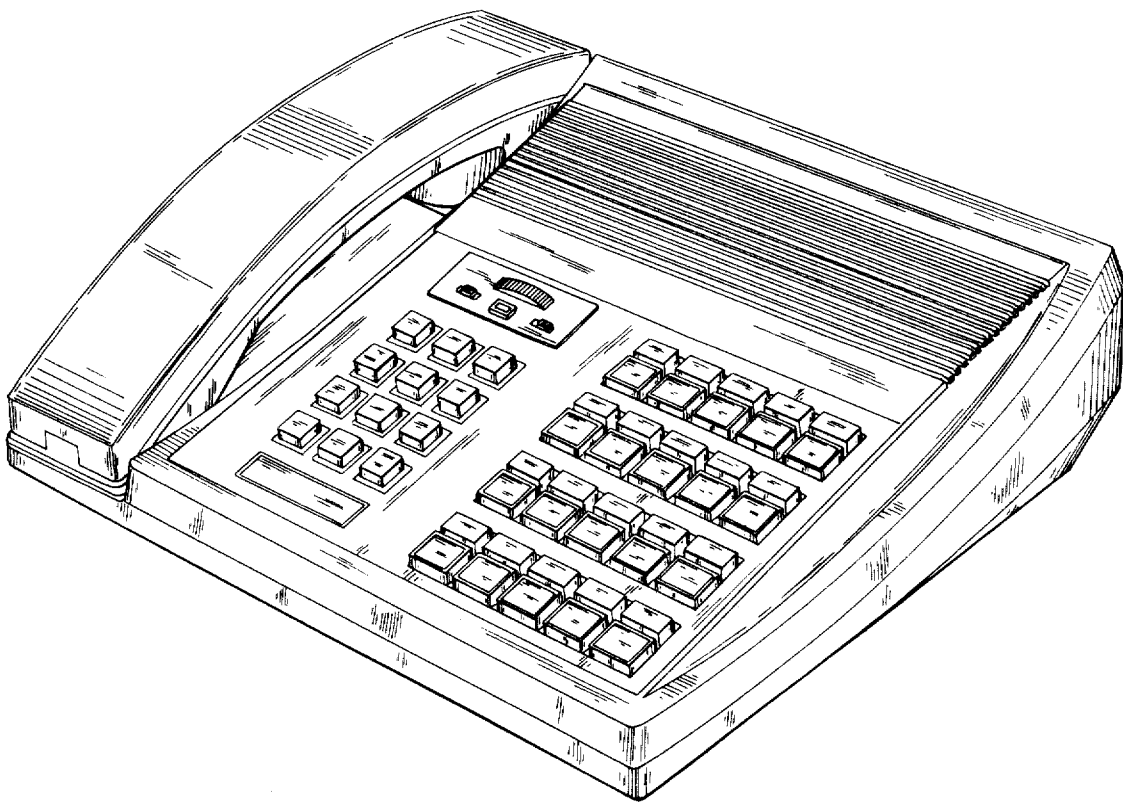

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a telephone instrument, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front of a telephone instrument showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a further embodiment thereof.



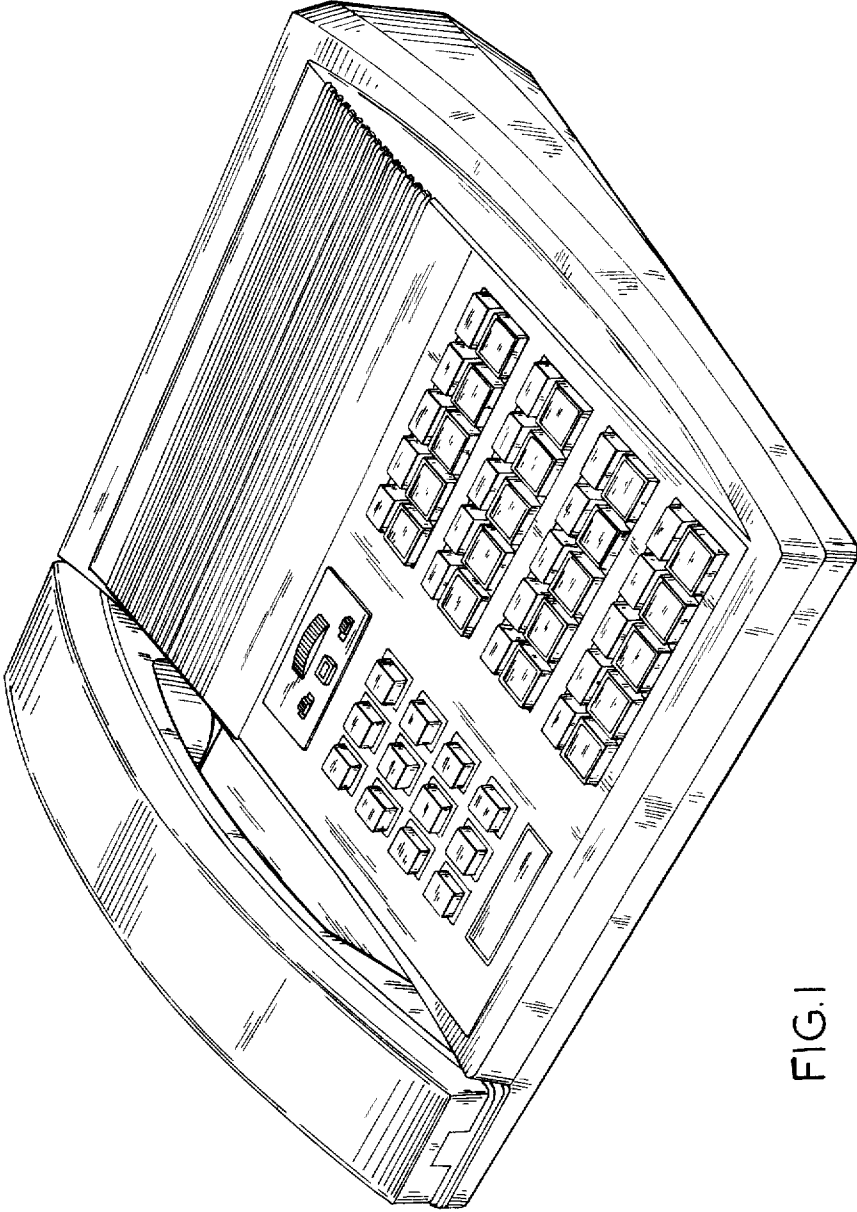

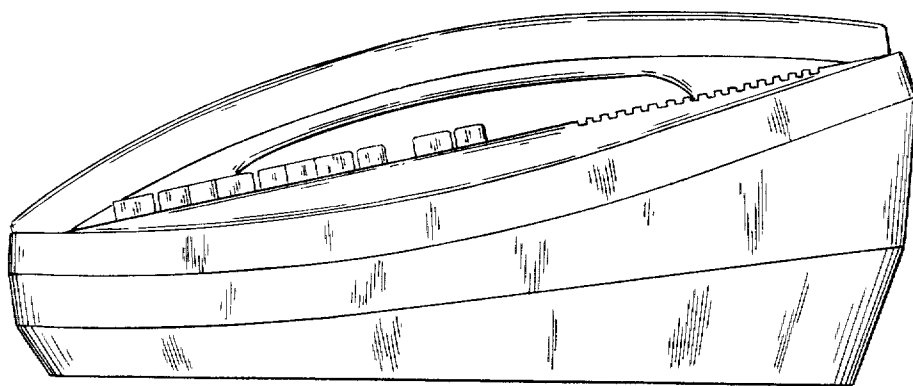

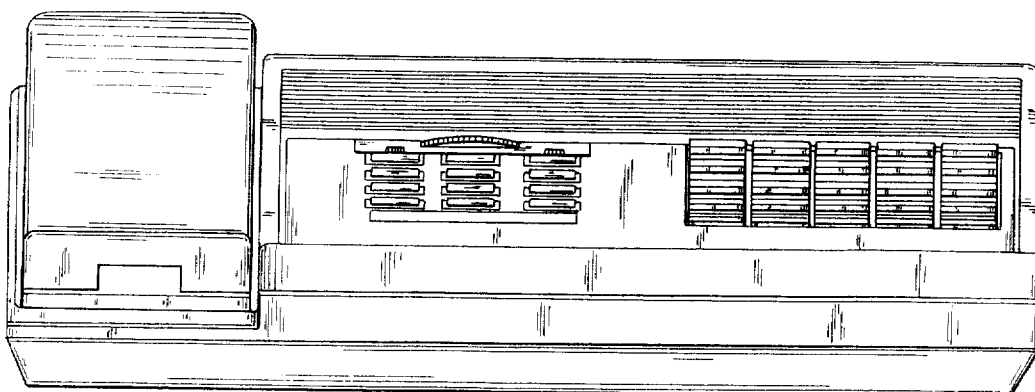

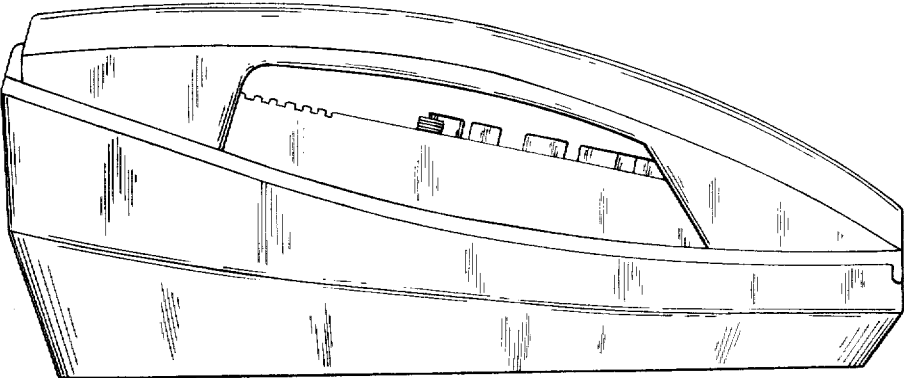

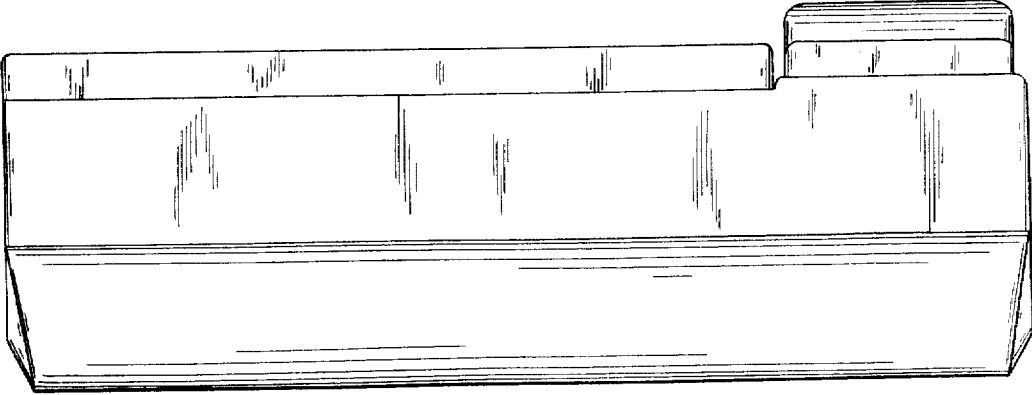

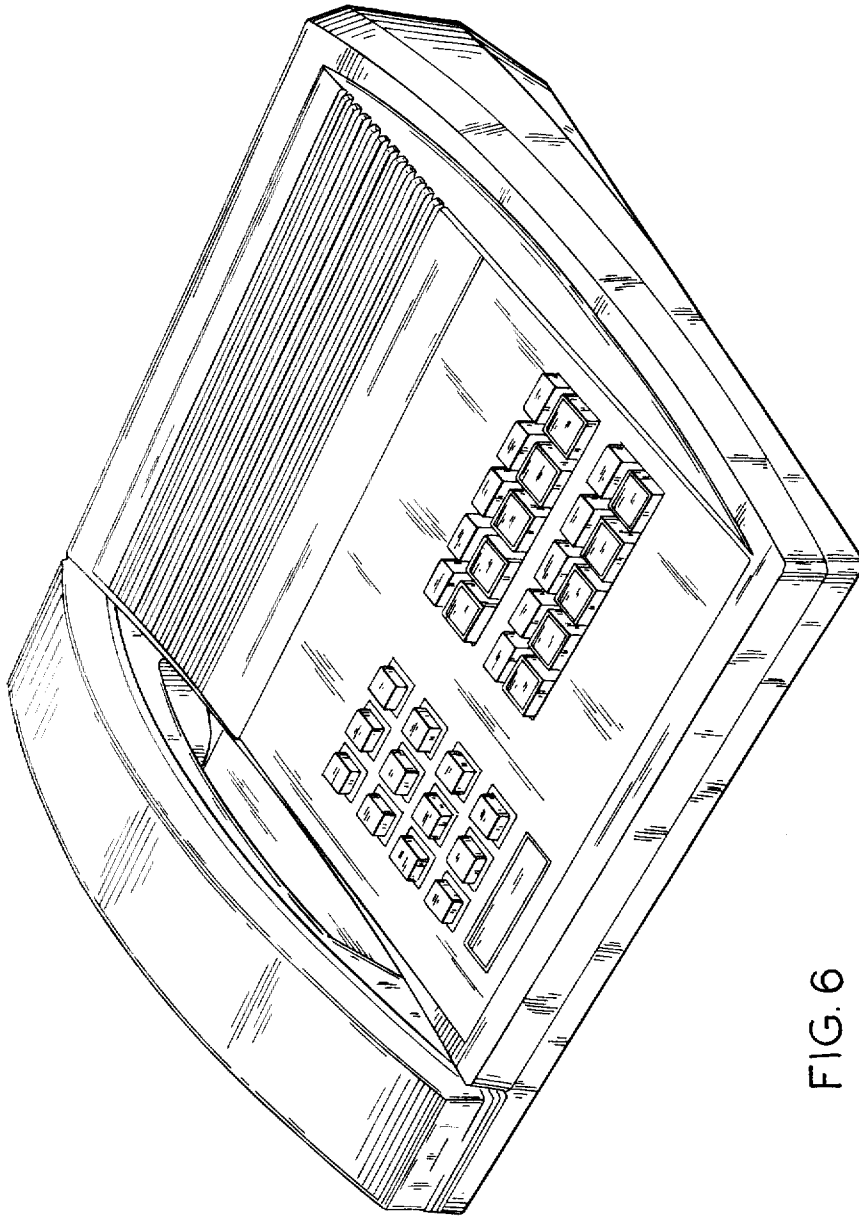
