




## DESIGN FOR A TUMBLER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edwin W. Fuerst, a citizen of the United States, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Tumbler, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a tumbler showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.
