## DESIGN FOR THE ORNAMENTATION OF KNIFE-HANDLES.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,660, dated April 27, 1886.

Application filed March 29, 1886. Serial No. 197,046. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WALLACE N. KENYON, a citizen of the United States, residing at Birmingham, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Ornamentation of Knife and Fork Handles; and I do declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, forming a part thereof, showing a knife-handle ornamented according to my new design.

The leading feature of my design consists of raised figures on the knife-handle, representing conventionalized leaves, vines, flowers, &c., these raised figures covering more or less

completely the surface of the handle in the manner shown by the illustration. Some of the leaves, *a*, are represented as having smooth surfaces, while others, *b*, are rough, and the flowers *c* are six-petaled.

I claim—

The design for the ornamentation of knife and other similar handles herein shown and described, the same consisting of conventionalized vines, smooth and rough surfaced leaves, and petaled flowers.
