

(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a mini-camera and housing,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a mini-camera and housing showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged side-elevational view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof.













