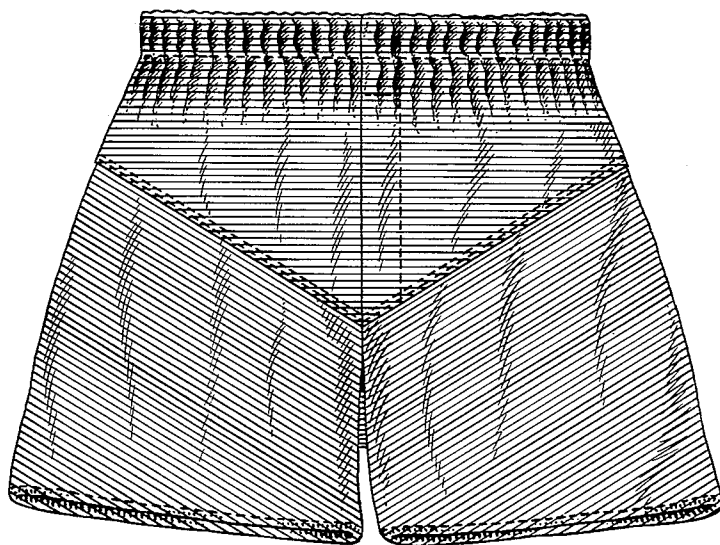

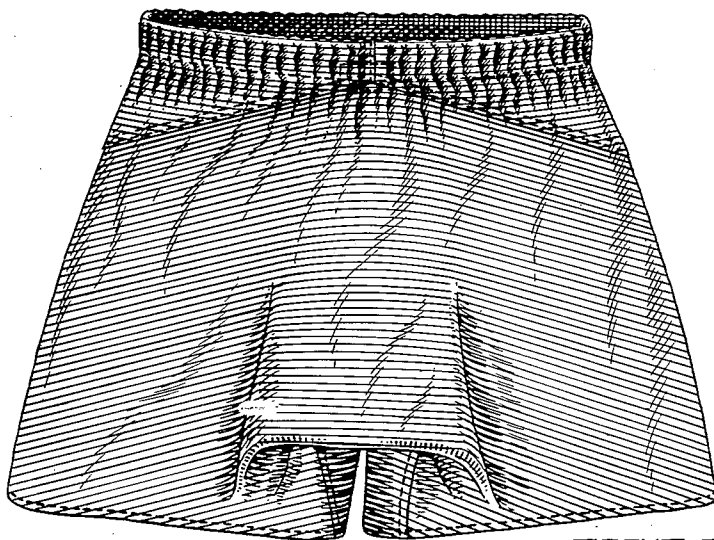

### *To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Trent B. Terry, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Charlottesville, in the county of Albemarle, and State of Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Shorts, of which the following is a specification, reference being made to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
