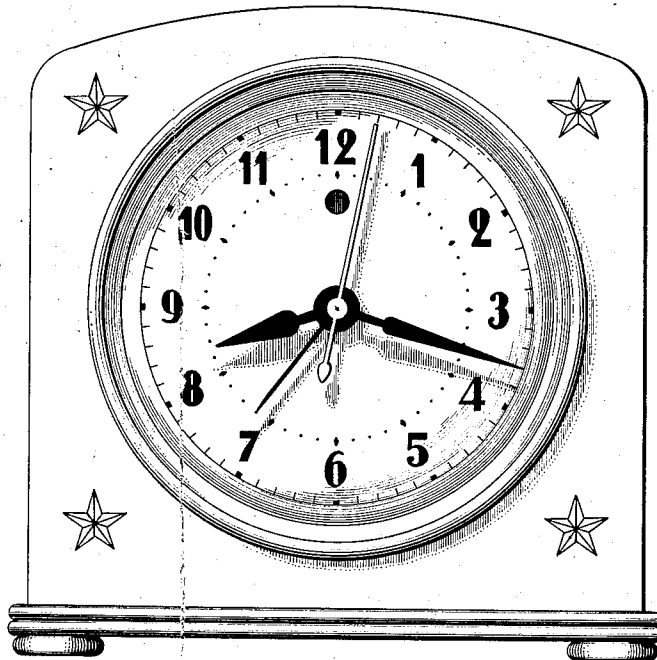
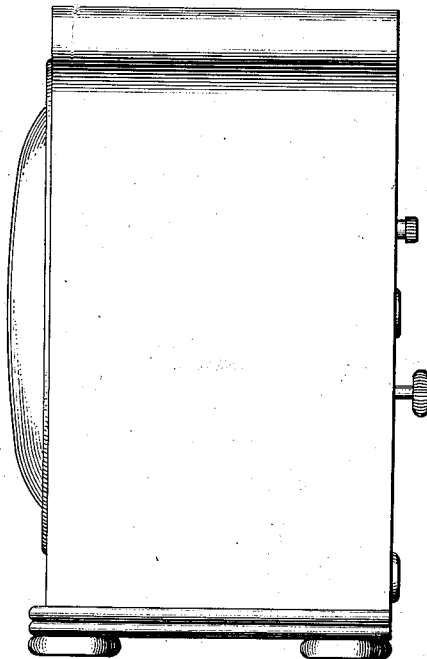

Be it known that I, John P.
