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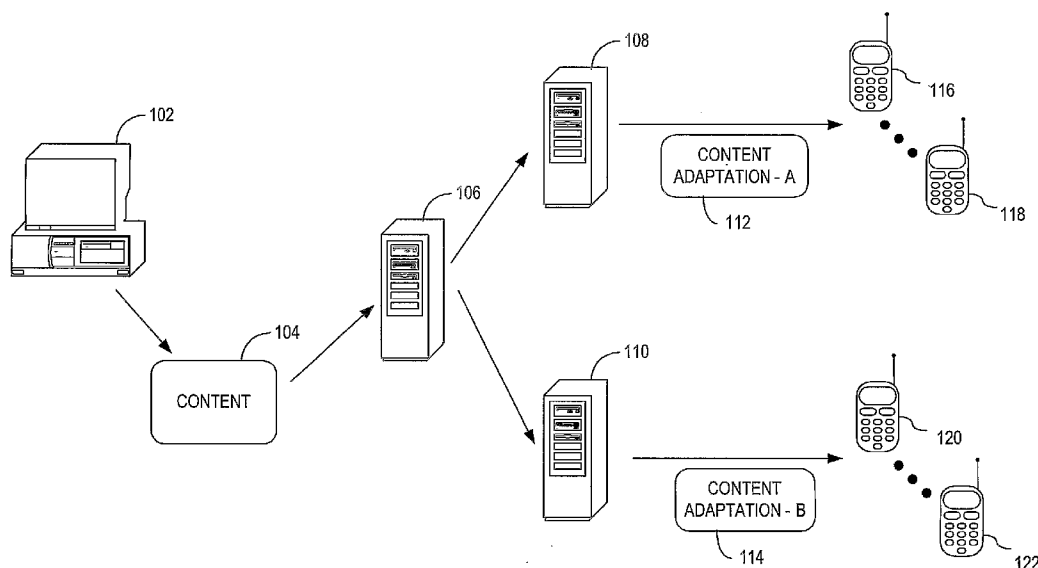

(54) Title: SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR EFFICIENT ADAPTATION OF MULTIMEDIA MESSAGE CONTENT



(57) Abstract: A system and method for providing previously adapted content to requesting network devices (see Figure 1). The requesting network device capabilities are compared to the previous requesting network device capabilities, such that if a capability match is found, previously adapted content may be transmitted to the requesting network device, obviating the need for an additional adaptation (see Figure 1). In another embodiment, a pre-adaptation method is employed, whereby content adaptations for all known network device capabilities are cached for future use (see Figure 1).
