DESCRIPTION

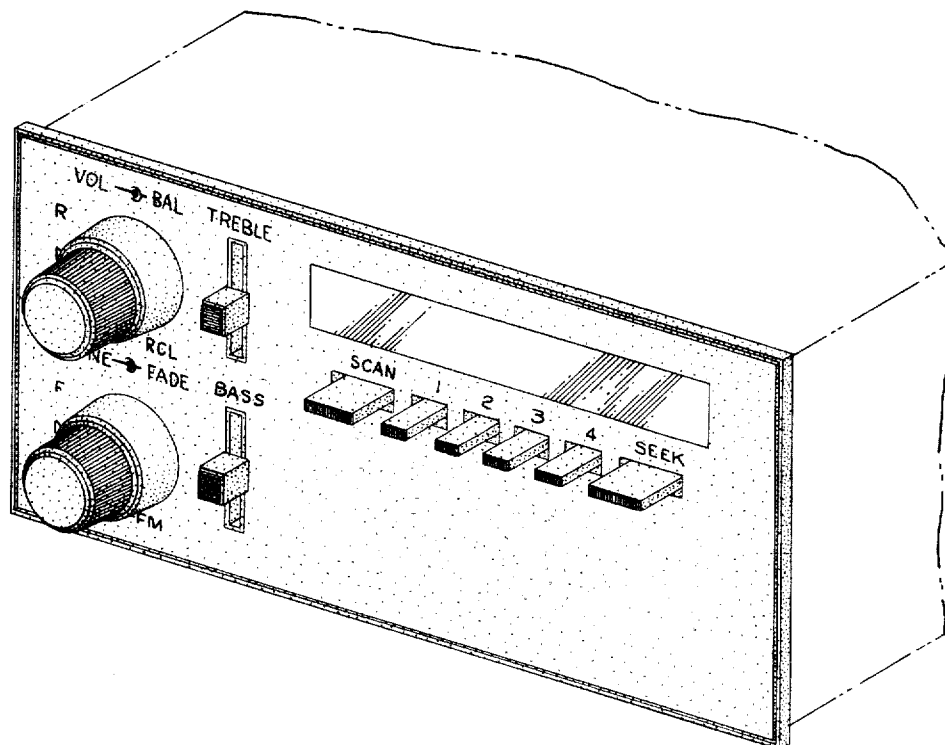
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a radio control unit showing our new design;

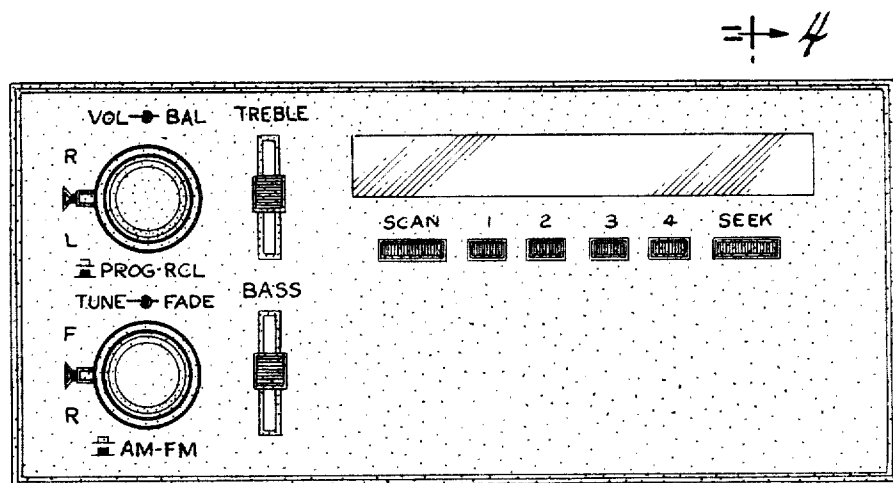

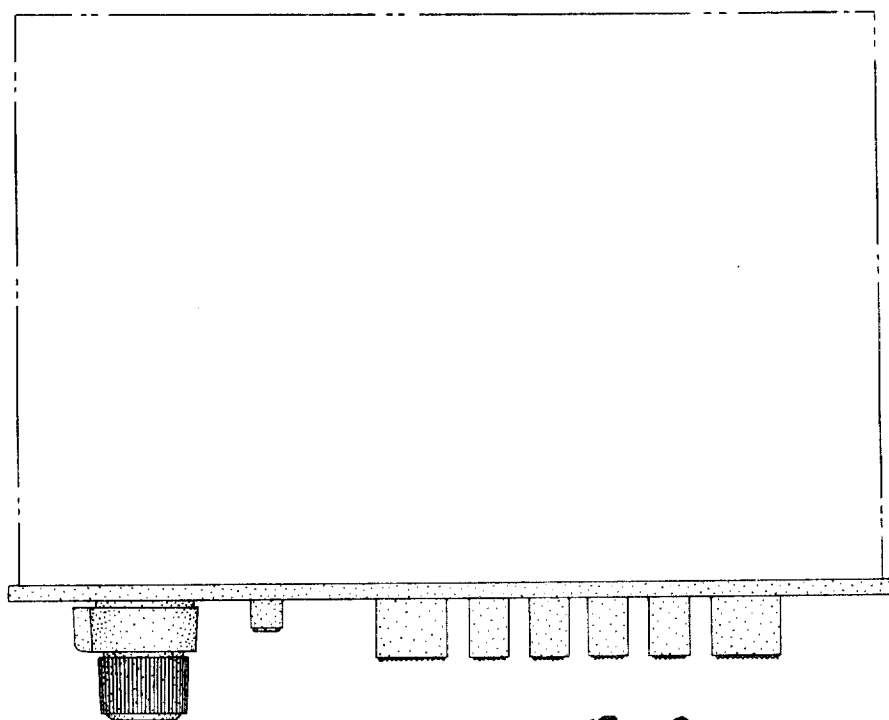

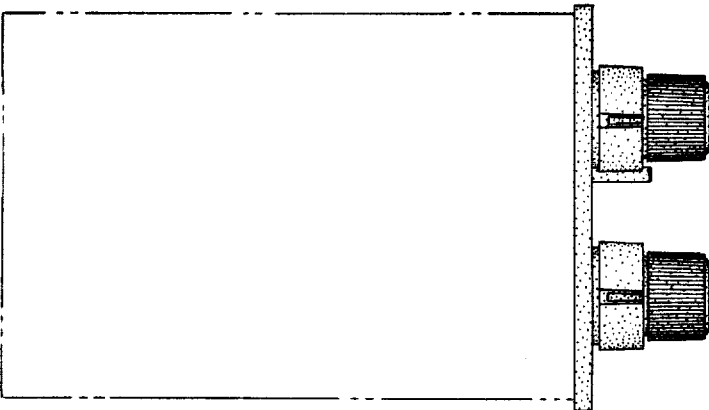

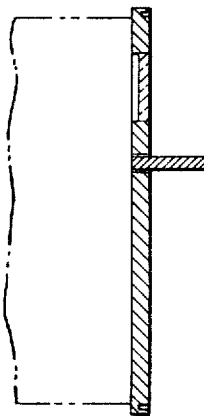

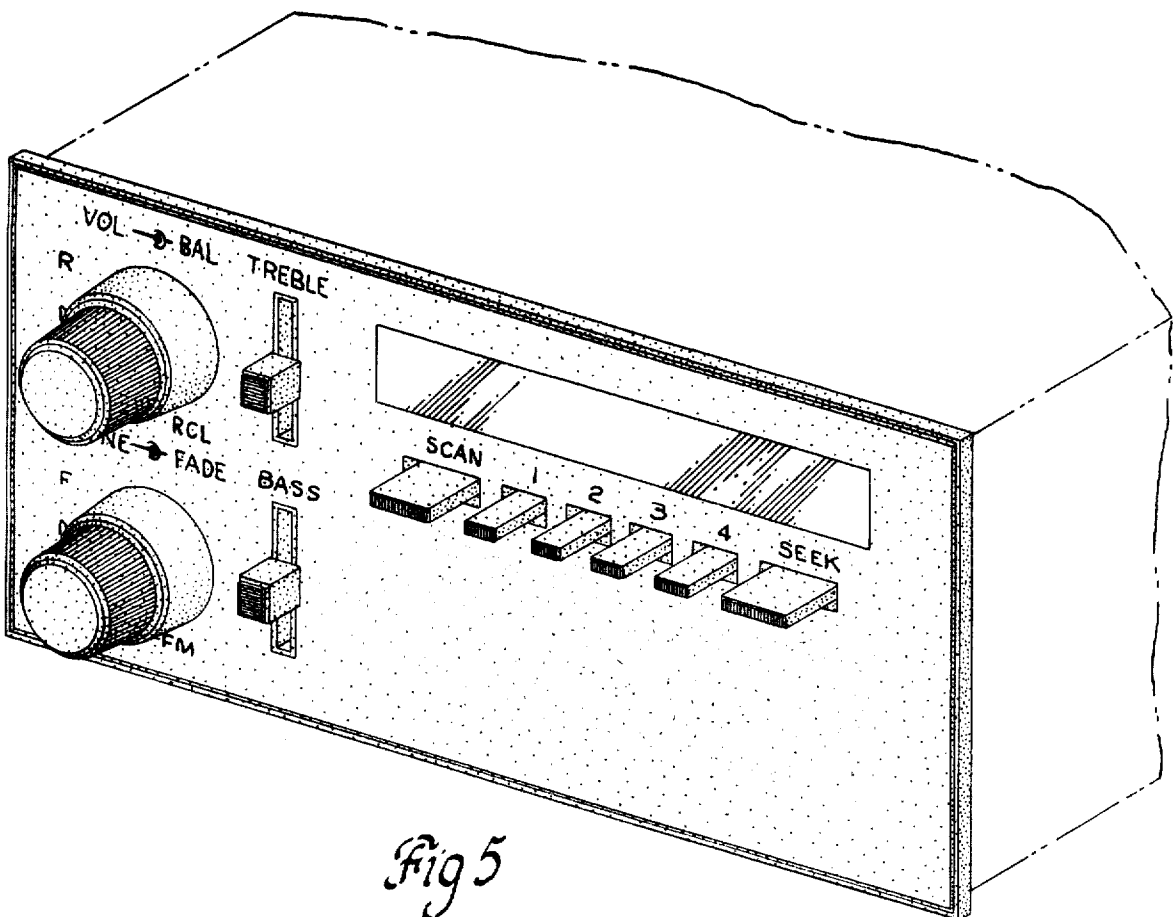
