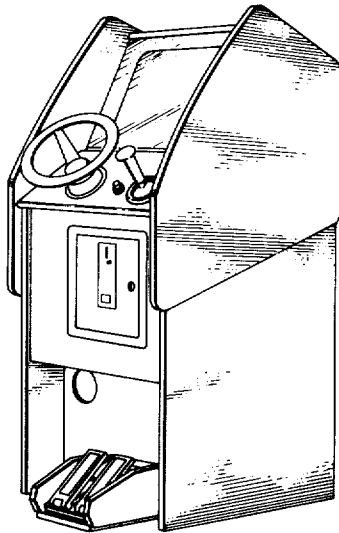

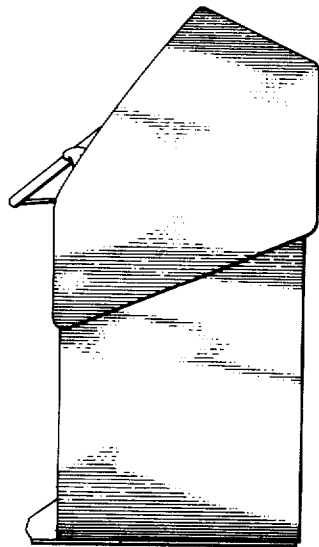
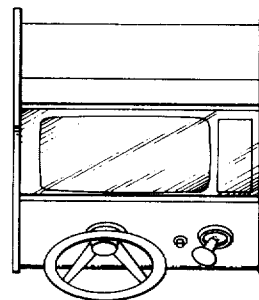

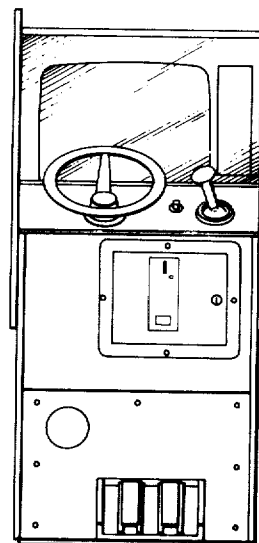

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the game cabinet shown in FIG. 1.

The back and bottom of the game cabinet are generally planar surfaces, and the right side is a mirror image of the left side.
