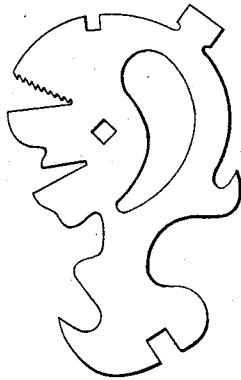

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALEXANDER G. MARION, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at River Rouge, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pocket-Tools, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—
