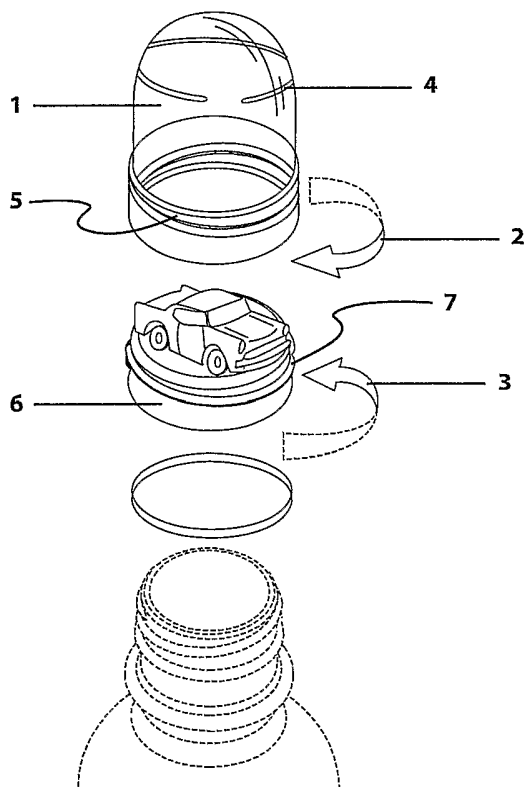

(54) Title: RECEPTACLE CONNECTABLE ON TOP OF A CAP CLOSURE



(57) Abstract: An upper cap (1) has a thread (5) to engage with a thread (7) of a container cap closure (6). The upper cap 1 provides a receptacle in which any required commodity can be contained such as a novelty car as shown. Clockwise or counter-clockwise rotation of the cap (1), shown as (2 or 3), can selectively remove the cap (1) without or with the cap (6). A plurality of caps 1 may be connected together to form a vertical stack.
