

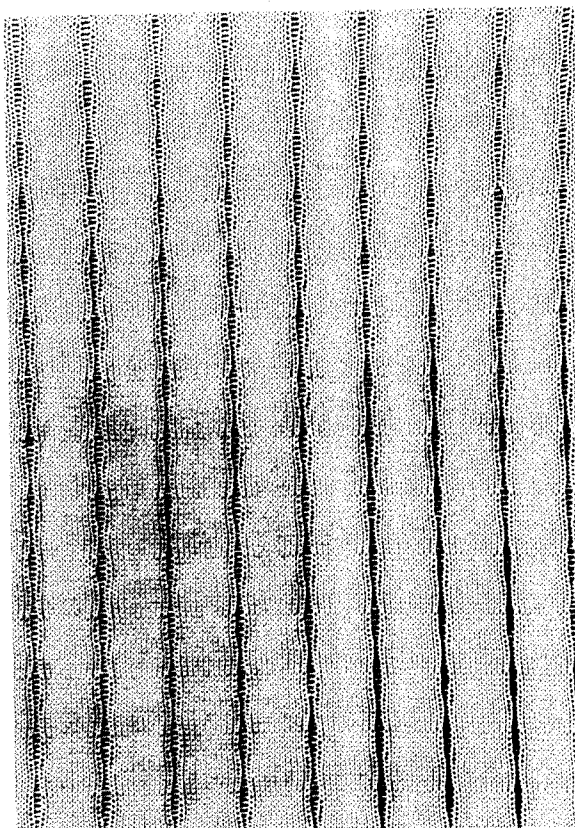

DESIGN FOR A KNITTED FABRIC

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jack Minoff, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Newark, county of Essex, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Knitted Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of the knitted fabric, showing open or drop stitches with the edge threads approaching and receding from each other at regular, recurrent points.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a knitted fabric, substantially as shown and described.
