The ornamental design for a chemiluminescent light stick, as shown and described.

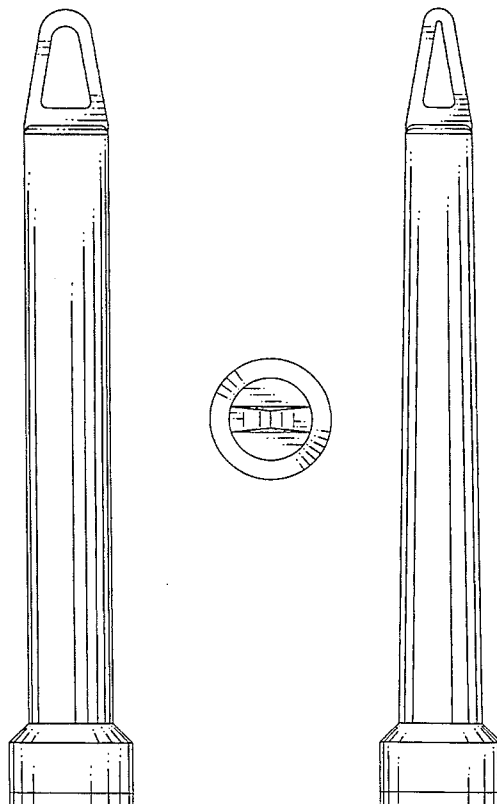
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cylindrical chemiluminescent light stick, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a frustoconical chemiluminescent light stick, showing my new design;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The bottom of the second embodiment is identical to that of the first embodiment as shown in FIG. 3.

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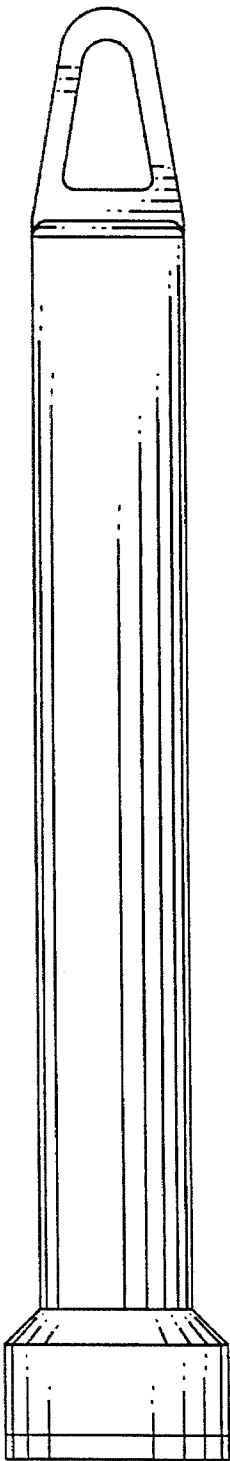

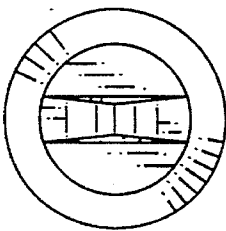

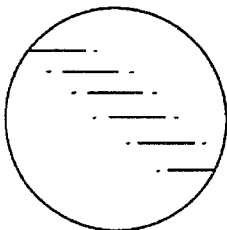

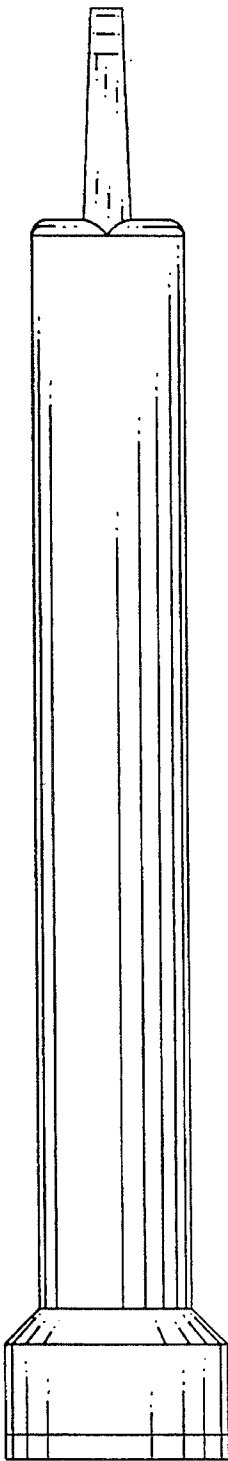

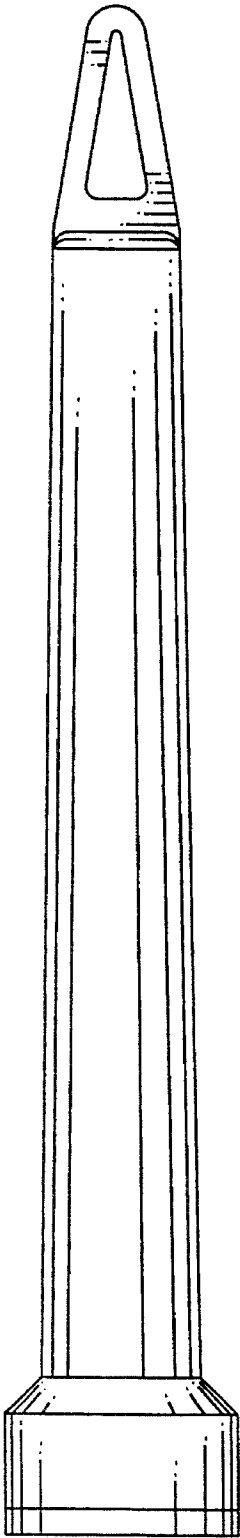

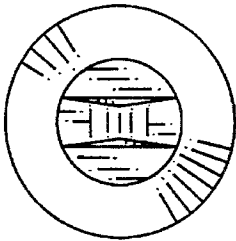

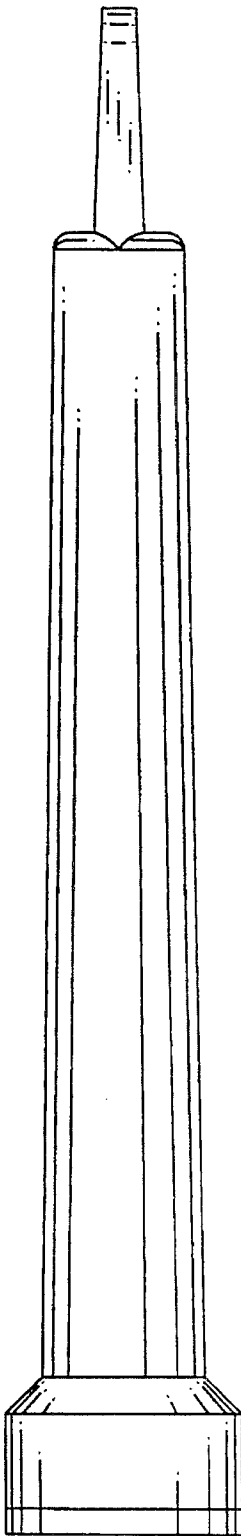
