

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max Gutschmidt, a citizen of the United States, residing at Union City, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a portion of a textile fabric or similar article showing my new design, a portion between the two selvage edges being broken away or omitted.
