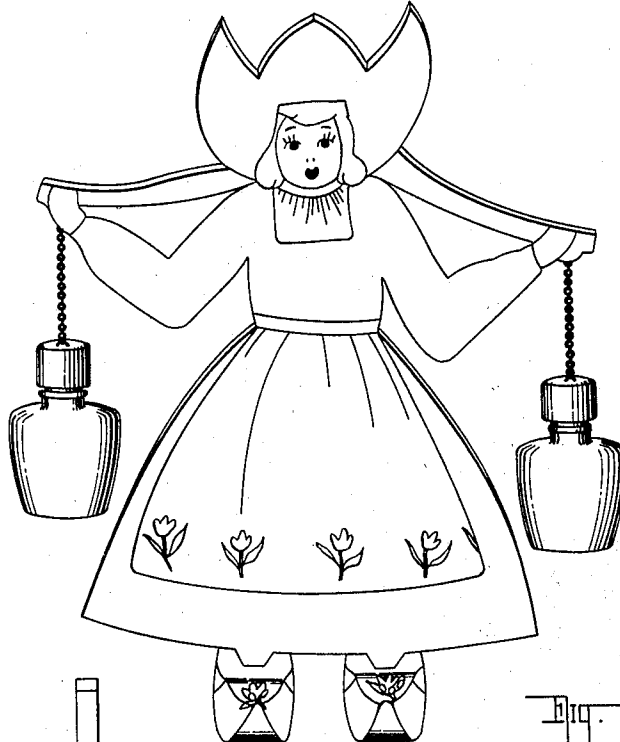

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Herman Jacob, a citizen of the United States, residing at St. Paul, county of Ramsey, and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Support and Containers for Perfume, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
