(54) Title: DIAGNOSTIC SYSTEM FOR DIFFERENTIATING SPUTUM FROM SALIVA

(57) Abstract: A novel diagnostic system for rapidly, non-invasively and inexpensively differentiating sputum from saliva. The disclosed methods utilize a test strip or stick assay, or other similar assays, for detecting the presence of leukocyte esterase which correlates to the presence of sputum in a patient sample.
