DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right side and top perspective view of a condensate separator showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear, left side and top perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear, top perspective view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear, right side and top perspective view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, on an enlarged scale; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, on an enlarged scale.
The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.













