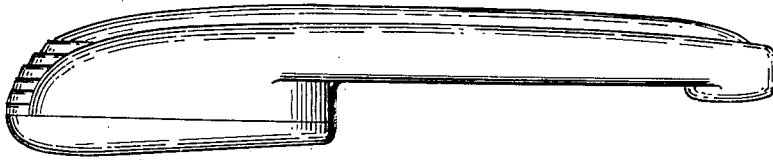

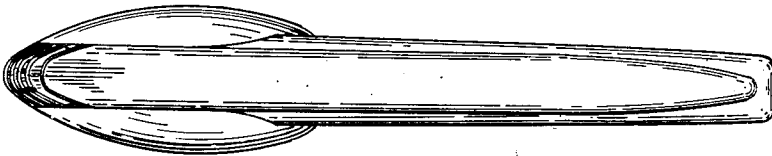

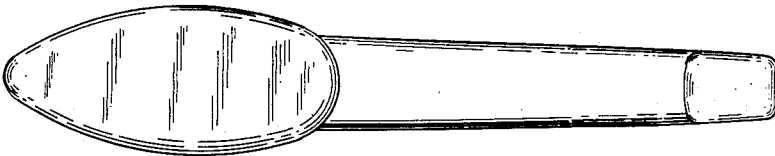

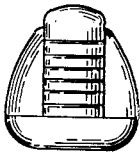
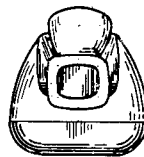

DESIGN FOR A MASSAGE DEVICE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Gustav Schwarz, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Northbrook, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Massage Device, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view; Fig. 2 is a top plan view; Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view; Fig. 4 is a front end elevational view; Fig. 5 is a rear end elevational view of a massage device embodying my new design.
