

DESIGN FOR A HANDBAG

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Henri Felmann, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Chicago, in the county of Cook, State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Handbag, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein.

Figure 1 is a front view of a handbag showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear view of the handbag shown in Figure 1.

The modified circular elements comprising the basic bag represent embossed leather.

The portions shown in full lines are continued throughout both sides of the handbag. The ends of the bag are substantially plain.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a handbag, substantially as shown and described.
