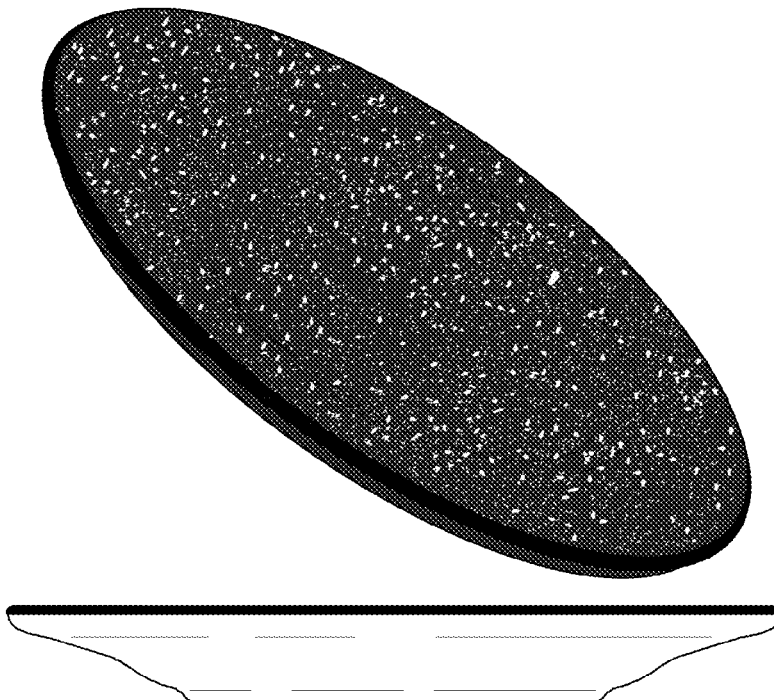
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of dinnerware according to an embodiment of the invention;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, with all sides being identical;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of dinnerware according to a second embodiment of the invention;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a front devotional view thereof, with all sides being identical.

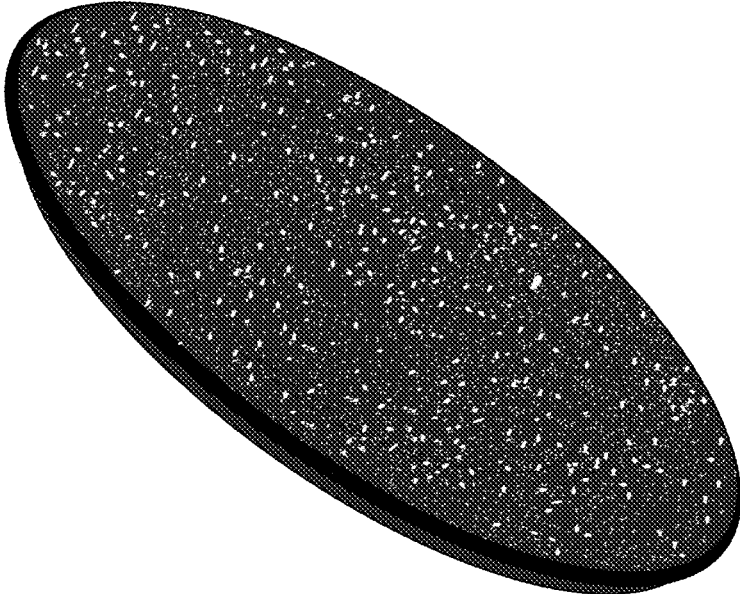

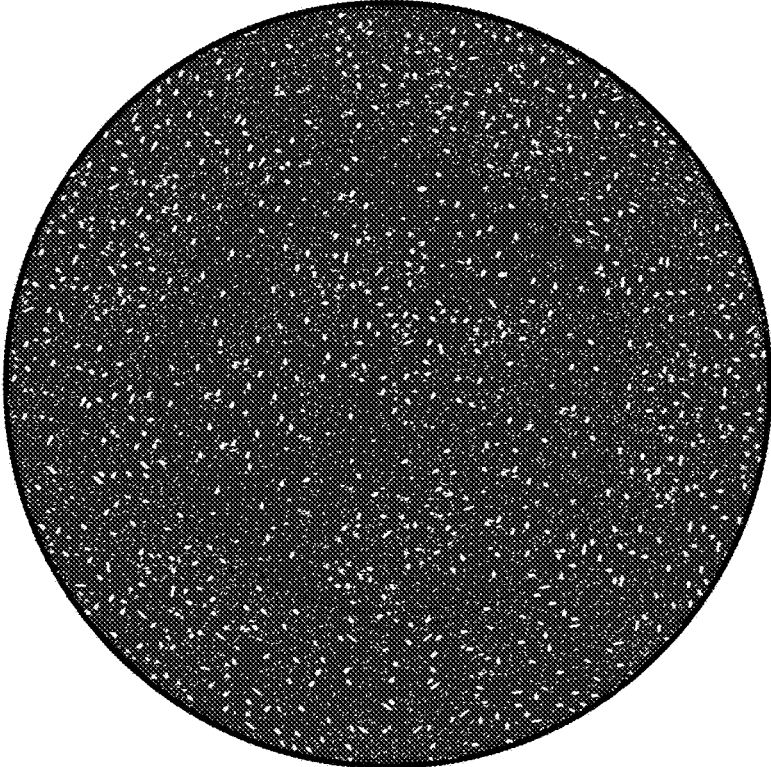

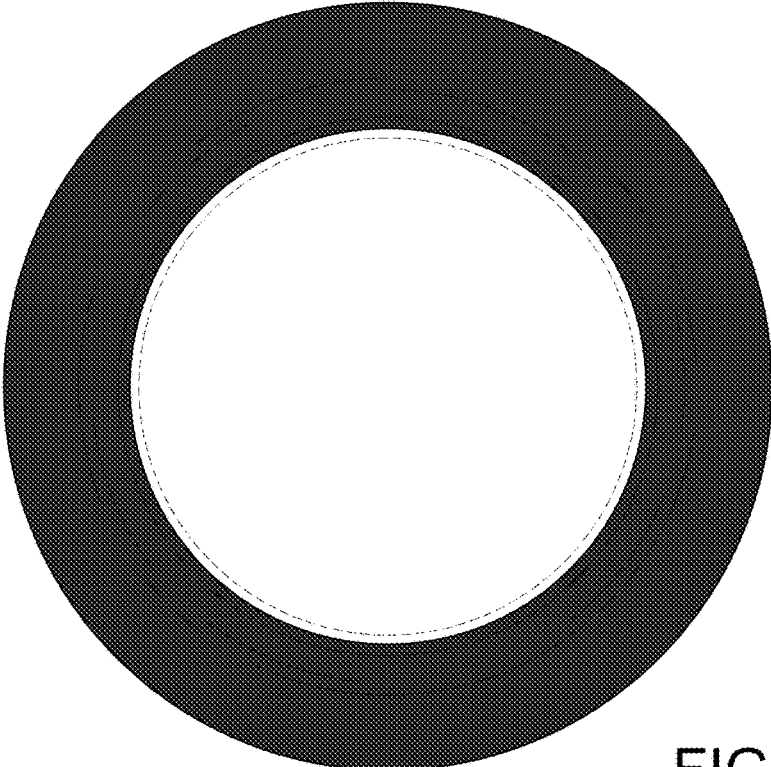

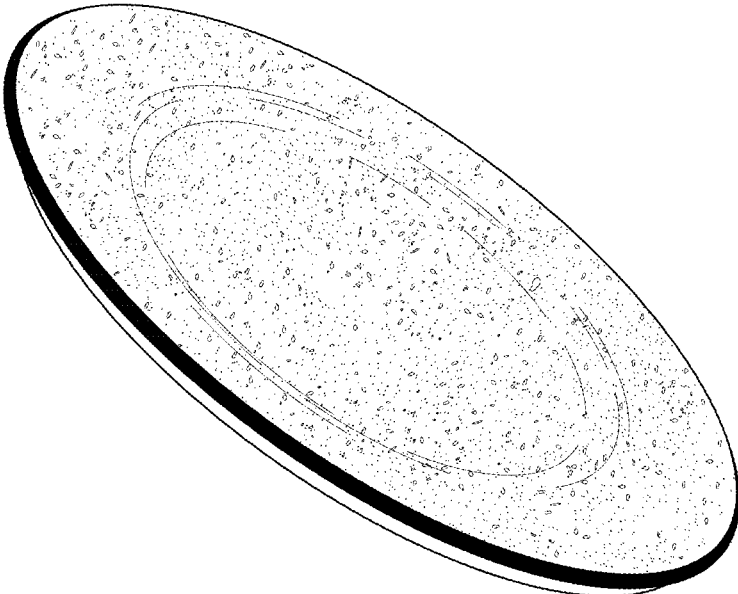

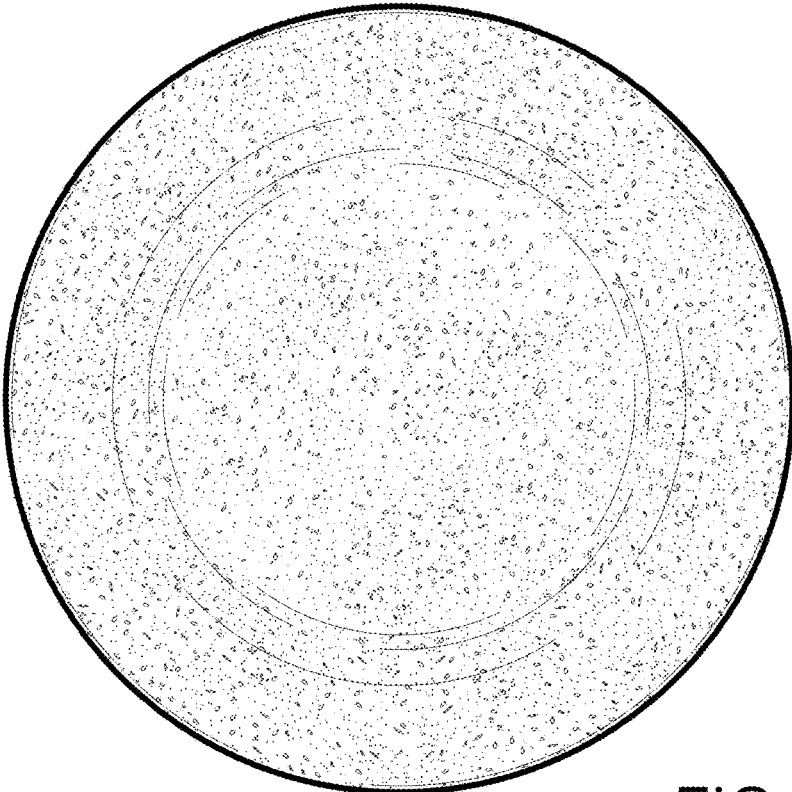

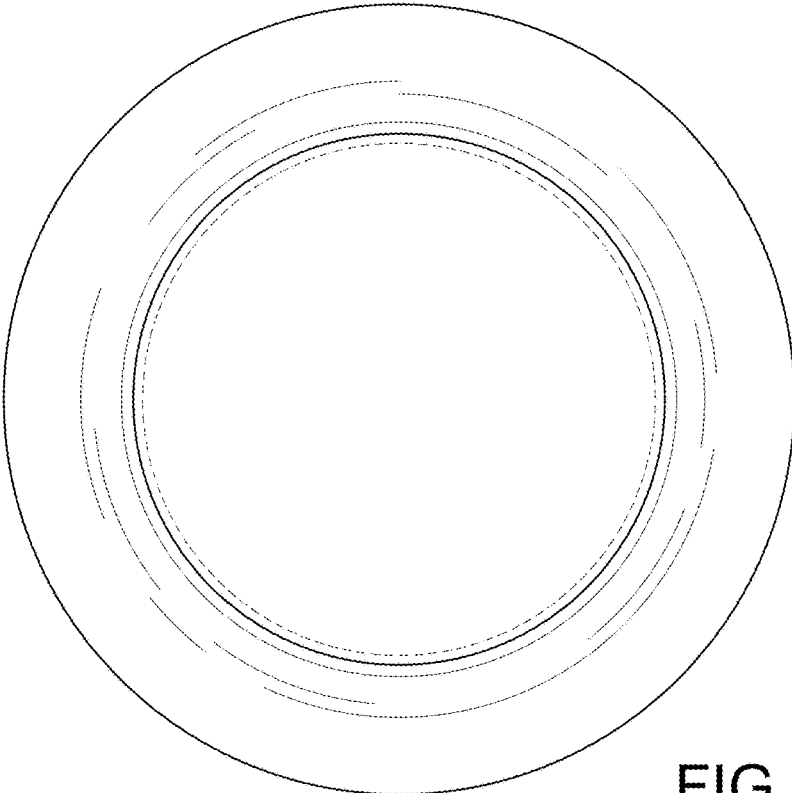
