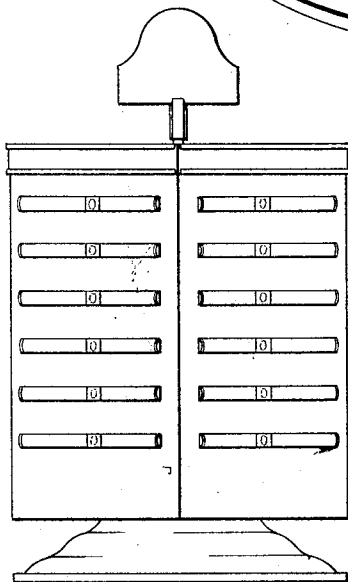
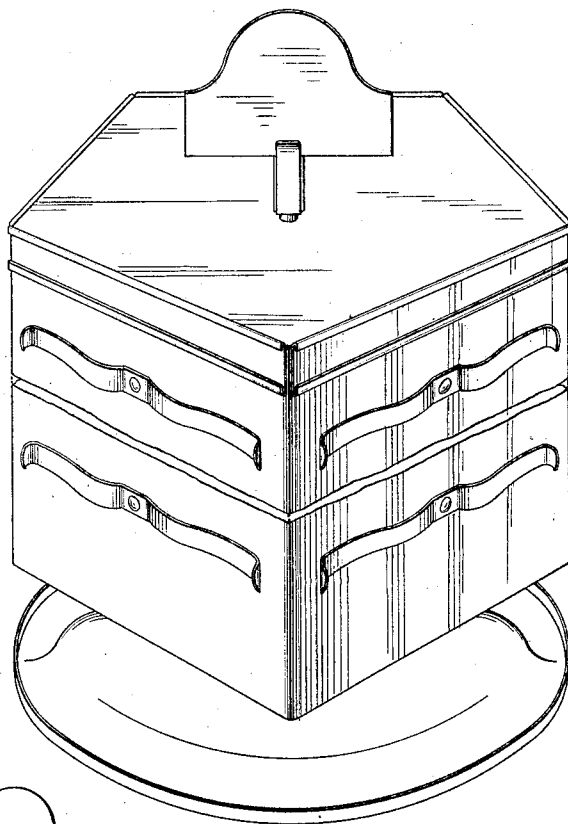

DESIGN FOR A VENDING STAND

Application filed November 7, 1931. Serial No. 41,652. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GUS KERCKEL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Vending Stand, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a fragmentary perspective view of the stand shown in Fig. 2.

Fig. 2 is a front view of the stand showing my new design.

The sides of the stand not shown have substantially the same appearance as those shown.
