To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK DEMER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Great Bend, in the county of Susquehanna and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Glass Vessels or Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side view of an article embodying the design; and Fig. 2 is a plan view of the same.

The design as illustrated in the drawing is a pond lily with stems and leaves.

The ornamental design for a glass vessel or similar article, as shown and described.
