

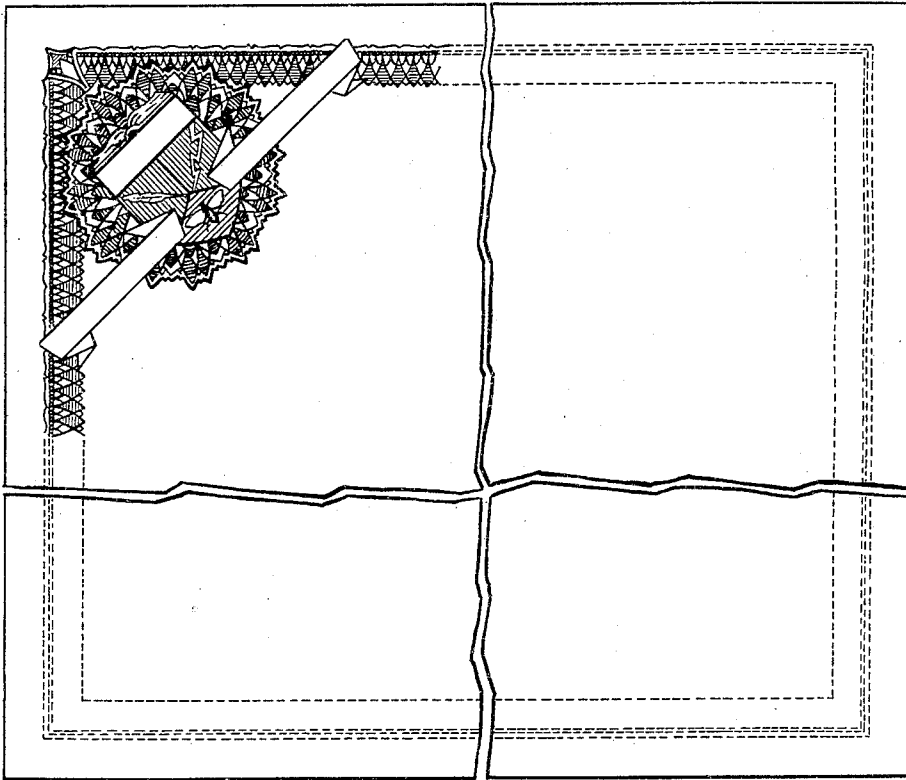

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Roger Connor, a citizen of the United States, residing at Athens, in the county of Athens and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Check or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a check or similar article showing my new design.

For convenience of illustration, the check has been shown as broken. While only a portion of the border has been illustrated in solid lines, it is understood that this border continues entirely around the check adjacent the edge thereof as indicated in broken lines.
