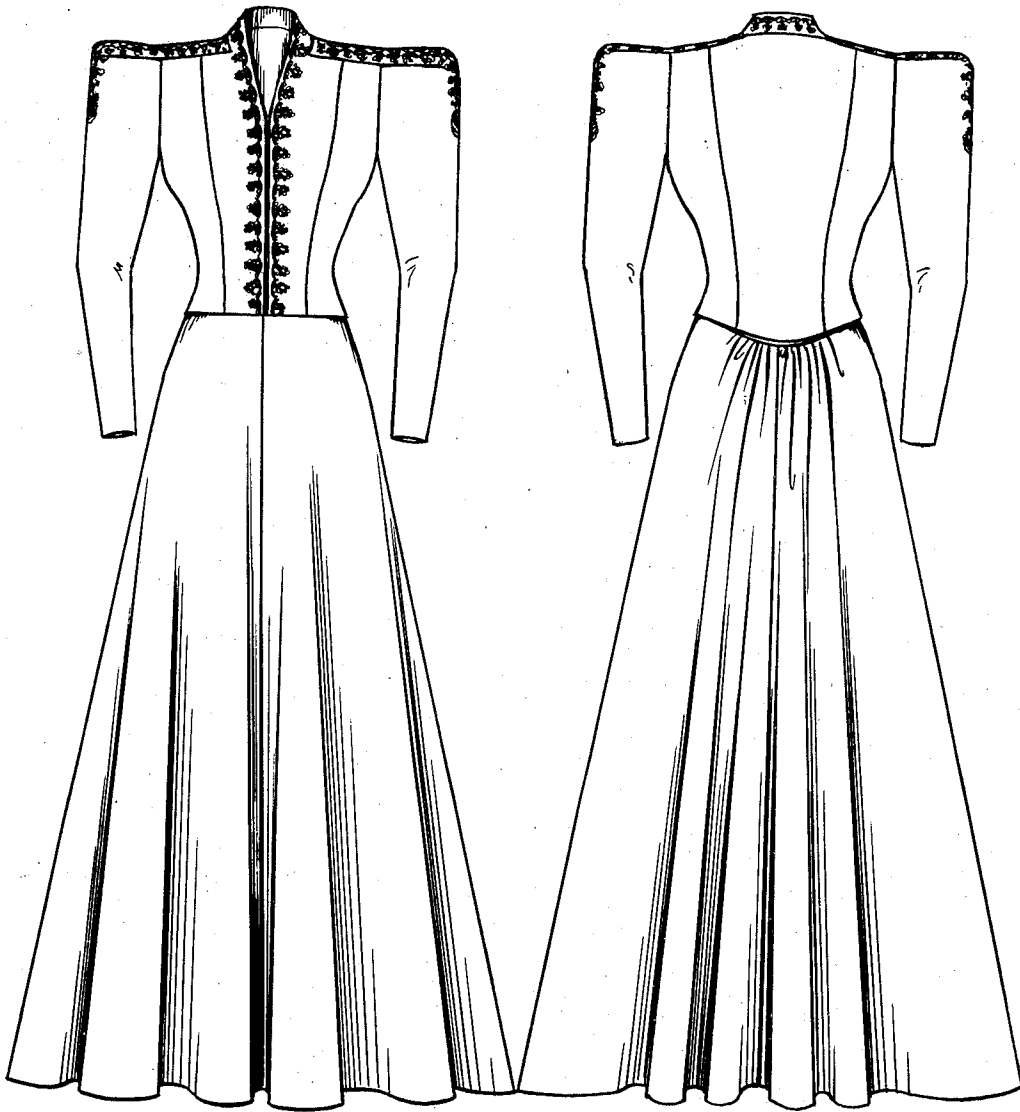

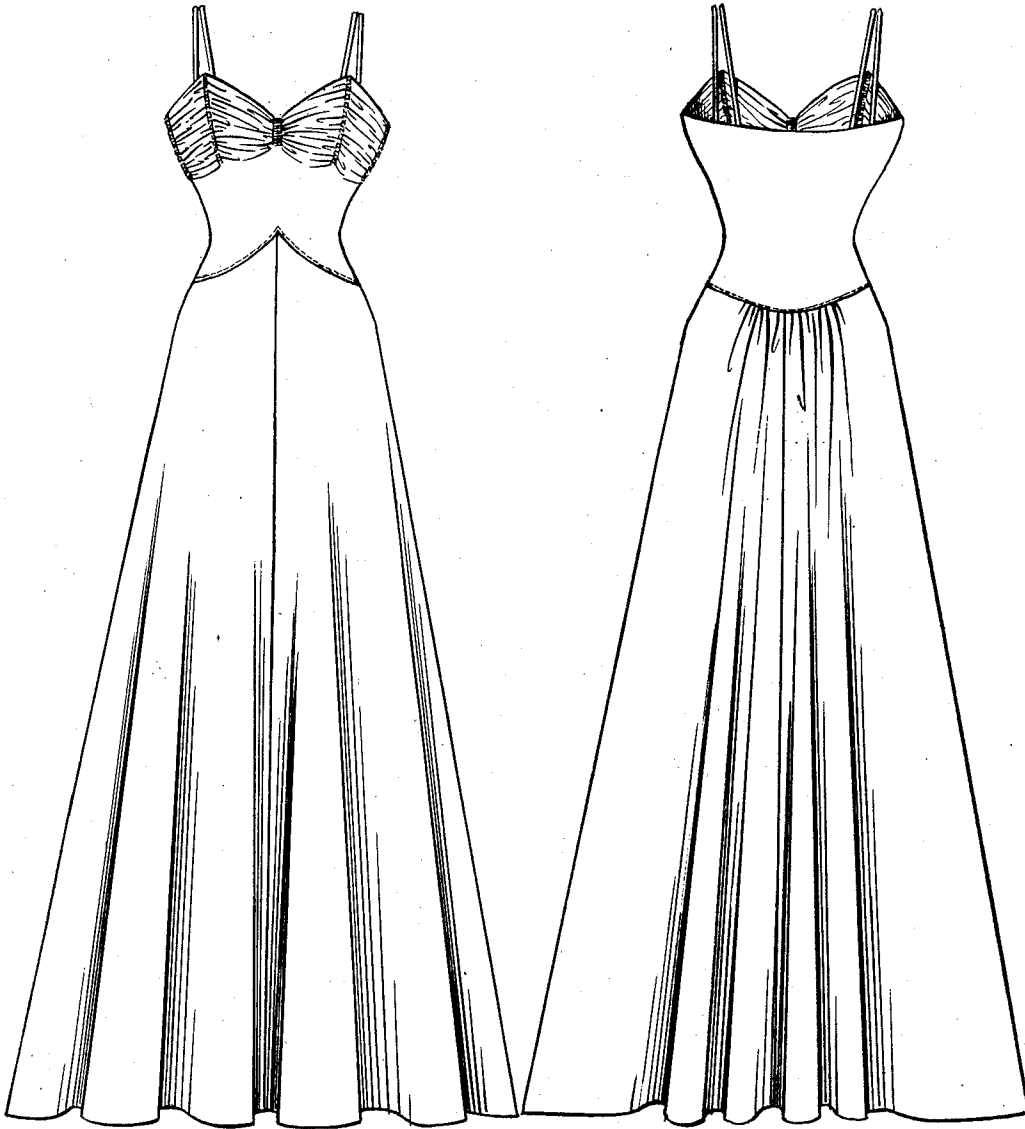

DESIGN FOR A DRESS ENSEMBLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Fred Perlberg, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a DRESS ENSEMBLE, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
