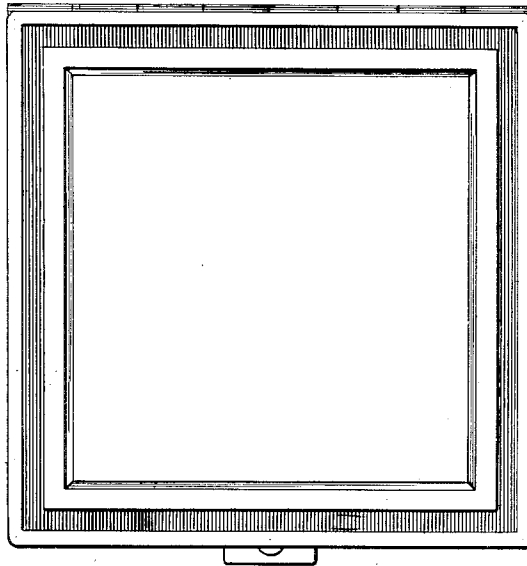

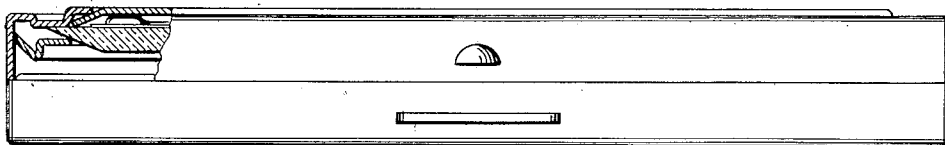

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, David H. Zell, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vanity Case or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a vanity case showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof, and,

Fig. 3 is a front end elevation on an enlarged scale, the top of the case being shown partly in section.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a vanity case or similar article substantially as shown and described.
