

DESIGN FOR A STOVE.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CONRAD HARRIS and PAUL W. ZOINER, of Cincinnati, county of Hamilton, State of Ohio, have invented a new and useful Design for a Coal and Wood Cooking-Stove, to be known and called the "Torch-Light;" and we do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying "photographs," and to letters of reference marked thereon, letter A showing the side and doors of stove.
