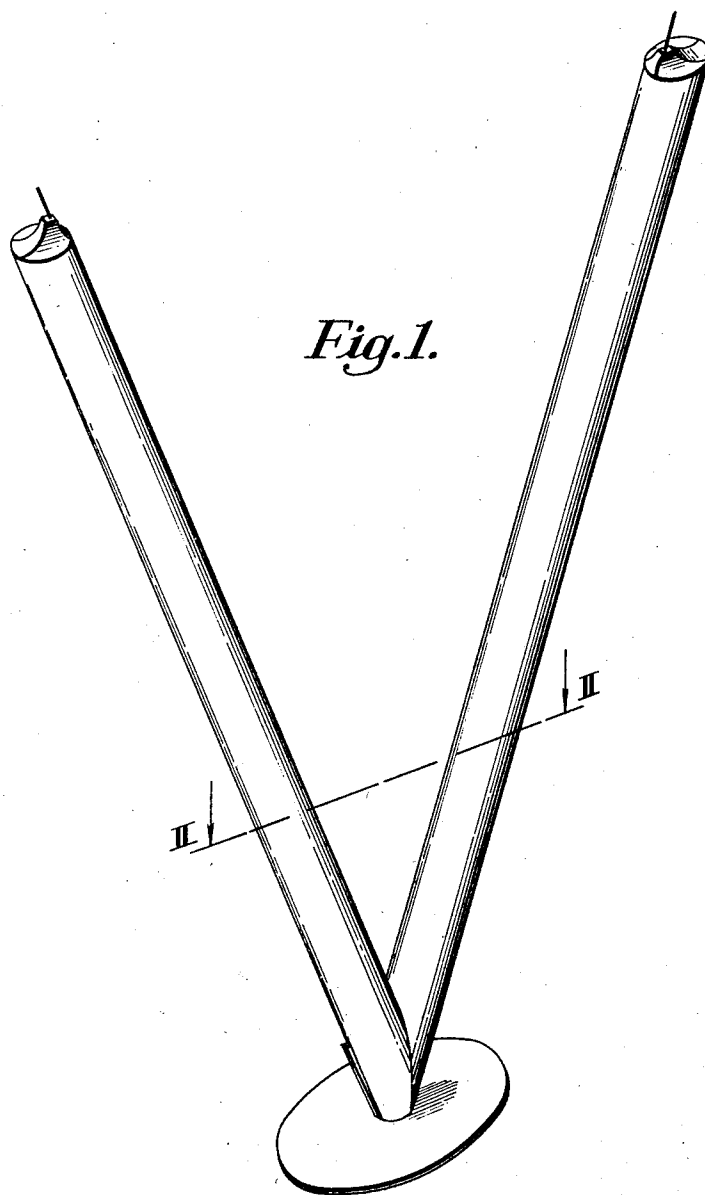
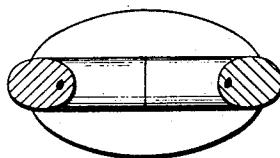

DESIGN FOR A CANDLE

Cameron Turner, Beverly, Mass.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Cameron Turner, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Beverly, in the county of Essex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Candle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a view in perspective of a candle, showing my new design, and

Fig. 2 is a view in cross section on the line 2—2 of Fig. 1 and in the direction of the arrows.

The dominant feature of my design is the two candle elements of circular cross section arranged in the form of a V with their surfaces intersecting in an acute angle, the elements diverging upwardly from a flat elliptical base, all as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a candle, substantially as shown and described.
