




To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NORMAN F. STEUER, a citizen of the United States and residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a bottle showing my design.

Fig. 2 is an elevational view of the side opposite that shown in Fig. 1.

Fig. 3 is a top plan view.
