

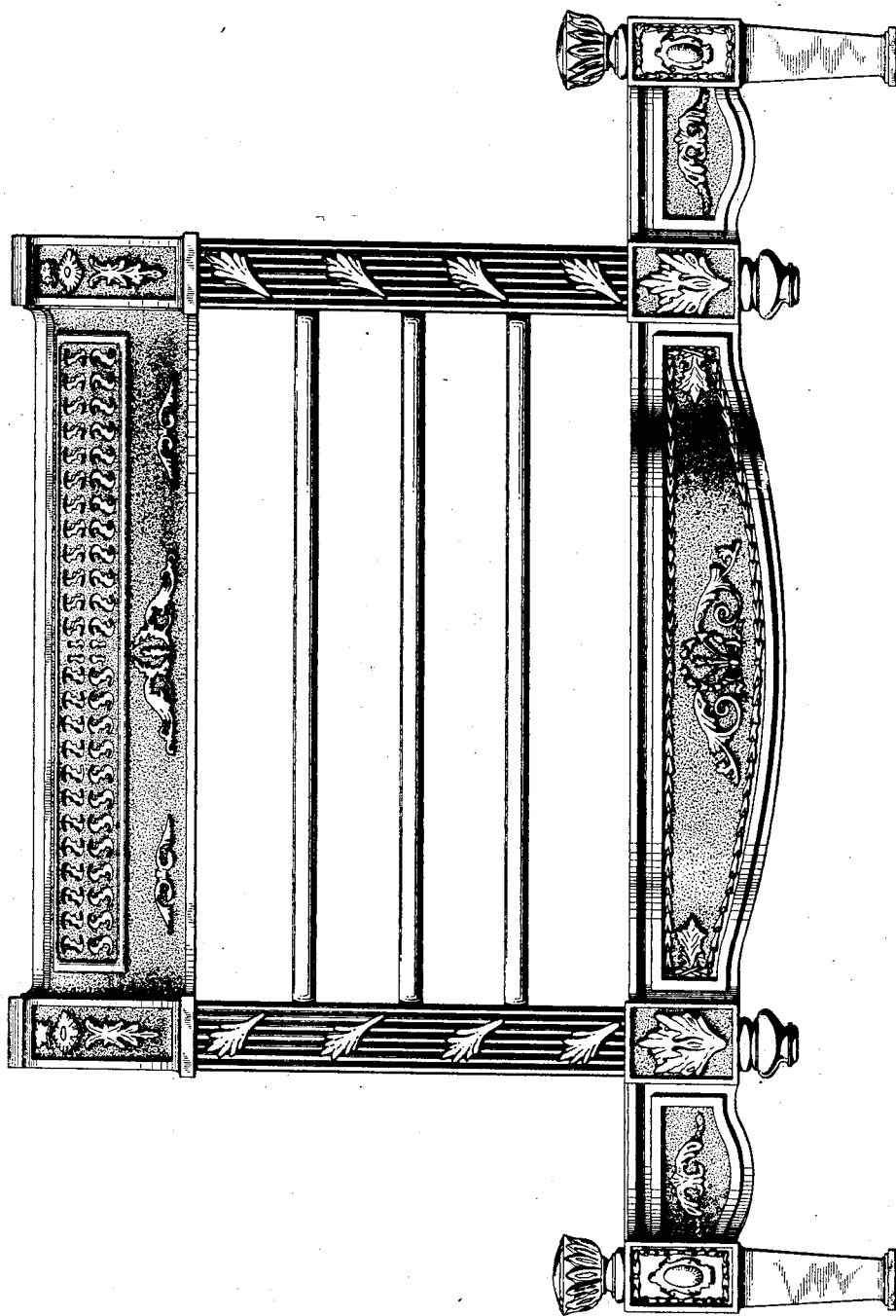

DESIGN FOR A FIREPLACE HEATER.

Application filed September 13, 1923. Serial No. 7,194. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:
