(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for the container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper perspective view of a container in accordance with our new claimed design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the container in FIG. 1, with right, left, and rear elevational views being identical to the front elevational view.

FIG. 3 is a top view of the container in FIG. 2; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the container in FIG. 1.

Dash-dash broken lines shown in the drawings illustrate portions of the container that form no part of the claimed design.

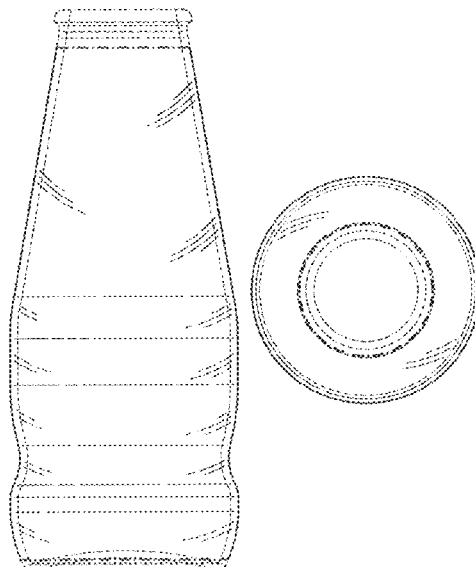
Dash-dot broken lines shown in the drawings represent boundaries of the claimed design and form no part of the claimed design.

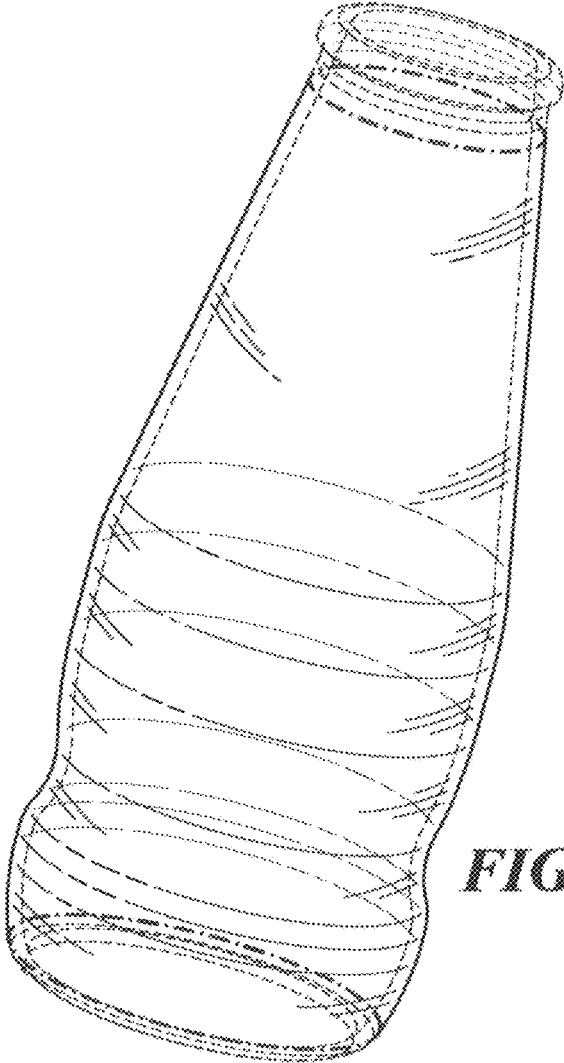

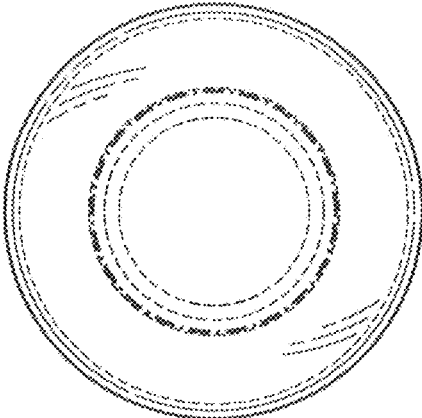

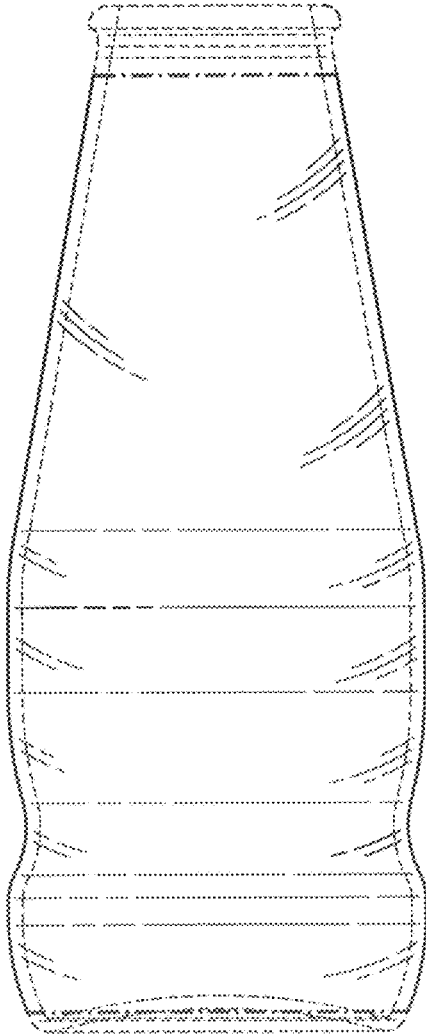

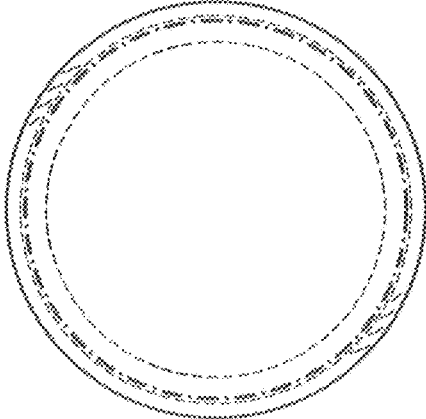
