

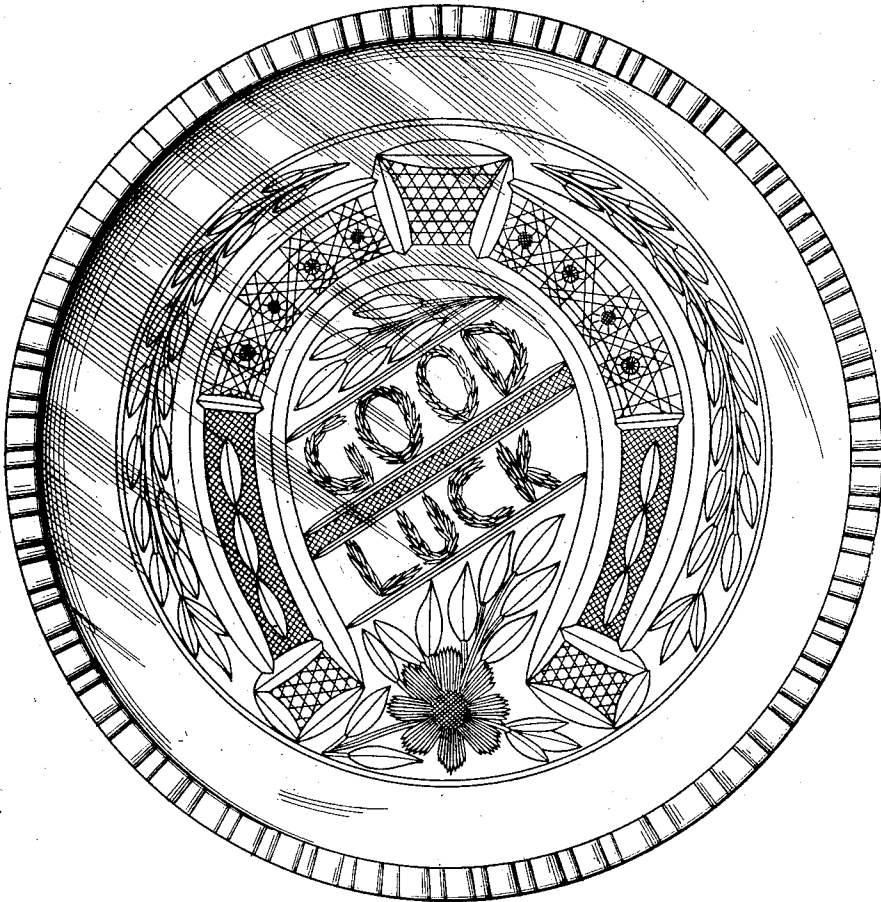

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FRANCIS R. SMITH, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of New York, borough of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Cut-Glass Dishes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a face view of a dish show-

ing my new design applied to the bottom thereof. The shape of the dish *per se* is, however, not novel.

The ornamental design for a cut glass dish, as shown.
